Jesus Betrayed by the Jewish People

John 19, Jesus Sentenced to Be Crucified, Then Pilate took Jesus and had him flogged. ² The soldiers twisted together a crown of thorns and put it on his head. They clothed him in a purple robe ³ and went up to him again and again, saying, "Hail, king of the Jews!" And they slapped him in the face. ⁴ Once more Pilate came out and said to the Jews gathered there, "Look, I am bringing him out to you to let you know that I find no basis for a charge against him." ⁵ When Jesus came out wearing the crown of thorns and the purple robe, Pilate said to them, "Here is the man!" ⁶ As soon as the chief priests and their officials saw him, they shouted, "Crucify! Crucify!" "You take him and crucify him. As for me, I find no basis for a charge against him." ⁷ The Jewish leaders insisted, "We have a law, and according to that law he must die, because he claimed to be the Son of God." ⁸ When Pilate heard this, he was even more afraid, ⁹ and he went back inside the palace. "Where do you come from?" he asked Jesus, but Jesus gave him no answer. ¹⁰ "Do you refuse to speak to me?" Pilate said. "Don't you realize I have power either to free you or to crucify you?" ¹¹ Jesus answered, "You would have no power over me if it were not given to you from above. Therefore the one who handed me over to you is guilty of a greater sin." ¹² From then on, Pilate tried to set Jesus free, but the Jewish leaders kept shouting, "If you let this man go, you are no friend of Caesar. Anyone who claims to be a king opposes Caesar." ¹³ When Pilate heard this, he brought Jesus out and sat down on the judge's seat at a place known as the Stone Pavement. ¹⁴ It was the day of Preparation of the Passover; it was about noon. "Here is your king," Pilate said to the Jews. ¹⁵ But they shouted, "Take him away! Take him away! Crucify him!" "Shall I crucify your king?" Pilate asked. "We have no king but Caesar," the chief priests answered. ¹⁶ Finally Pilate handed him over to them to be crucified.

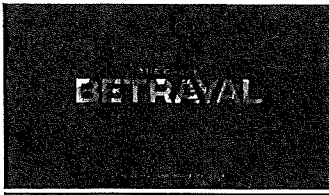
The Crucifixion of Jesus, So the soldiers took charge of Jesus. ¹⁷ Carrying his own cross, he went out to the place of the Skull (which in Aramaic is called Golgotha). ¹⁸ There they crucified him, and with him two others—one on each side and Jesus in the middle. ¹⁹ Pilate had a notice prepared and fastened to the cross. It read: jesus of nazareth, the king of the jews. ²⁰ Many of the Jews read this sign, for the place where Jesus was crucified was near the city, and the sign was written in Aramaic, Latin and Greek. ²¹ The chief priests of the Jews protested to Pilate, "Do not write 'The King of the Jews,' but that this man claimed to be king of the Jews."

²² Pilate answered, "What I have written, I have written." ²³ When the soldiers crucified Jesus, they took his clothes, dividing them into four shares, one for each of them, with the undergarment remaining. This garment was seamless, woven in one piece from top to bottom. ²⁴ "Let's not tear it," they said to one another. "Let's decide by lot who will get it." This happened that the scripture might be fulfilled that said, "They divided my clothes among them and cast lots for my garment." So this is what the soldiers did.

Life Application

Examine your life. If Jesus were to live today, or you would have lived in Jesus day. Based on the level of devotion you have to Jesus. Based on how passionate you are for Jesus today. Where do you think you would have been as Jesus was heading toward his death? Where do you think you would have been as Jesus hung on the cross?

Jesus' betrayal by Jewish People

READ: John 19:1-7

1. Did Pilate find anything against Jesus? Who wanted Jesus crucified?
2. Jesus claimed to be God. They had waited for Him for thousands of years why did they reject Him?
3. Have you ever said, it would be easier if I could just see Jesus? In light of this Scripture would it truly make it any easier?
4. Most people are happy with a leader until they do something that means they have to change something within self. Discuss this... What might some of those things be today?
5. At the end of Jesus' life, we see only a few people who remained with Jesus, why?
6. Pastor Adam said, "It is no different today. We have hundreds here on a weekend, yet how many of us really serve like Jesus calls us to? How many of us just sit back and want to consume good teachings at church...but do nothing with it? How many of us LOVE to talk like we are Christians but do not live like someone transformed by a REAL relationship with Jesus?" These were hard questions and probably hit home with some of the people reading this right now. Discuss.
7. Why do we think we would respond differently if Jesus were standing in front of us? And if you would indeed act differently what does that tell you?

READ: John 19:8-16

8. How did Jesus respond and how did the people respond?

A quote from Pastor Adam... They just declared a pagan as their King, a man who did terrible things and who also claimed to be God. Any of us can look at that and think how terrible it is and miss the fact that we do it all of the time. Don't forget in this passage the good church going people that should know what God stands for and what God opposes are the ones declaring their king is another person who claims to be God. So, how is this like you and me? Well, do we ever side with politics over God? Do we side with a political party who stand for things that God is directly opposed to? Do we side with a political person who acts in a way that is totally ungodly? Do we stand with people who directly oppose God in their actions or words?

Discuss this quote

READ: John 19:17-24

9. It is easy to judge these people, yet we have the full Bible and still do and believe things in direct opposition to the WORD. What are some of those things? What should we do about this?
10. Pastor Adam asked us to ponder this: We can think about the horrible things other people did to Jesus and forget something very important; **We did that to Jesus.** How?
11. Jesus, our Savior, was crucified by the religious people of his day. How close would we have been to Jesus as he walked with the cross on that last day? If you were there to witness Jesus' crucifixion; how near the cross would you have stood?
12. Is this something you have considered? in his final moments would your faith have put you near him?
