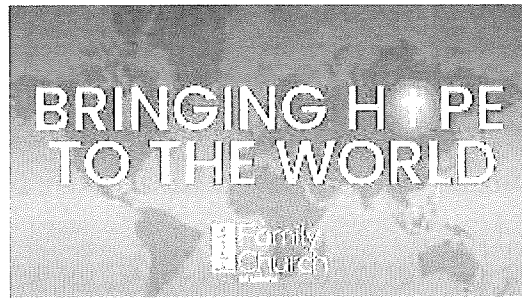

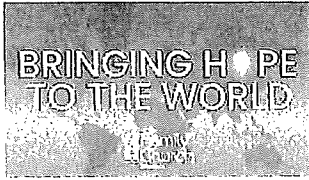

Life Application:

Jesus began his conversation with this woman by placing himself in the position of need first, "Will you give me a drink." Jesus reached out for help in a way she could meet His need. This is a great model for sharing Jesus with other people. This week allow yourself to be in a position of need, ask the person for help and then be willing to offer help in return; help that leads to saving their soul.

Hope in Brazil

READ: 1 Timothy 4:10

1. What does this verse teach us?
This whole month we are talking about how we bring this HOPE that Jesus talks about to the world.

READ: John 4: 1-42

2. Christianity is not simply learning things that will modify behavior. What is it about?

KEY POINT: To be transformed takes a REAL relationship with Jesus.

3. Have you ever wondered why this Christianity thing hasn't changed anything in your life or in the life of someone you know? What is the likely answer to that question?
4. Have you ever felt like an outcast? How did it affect your life? Have you ever treated another person like an outcast? What would Jesus have to say about that?
5. This story is about total transformation. Discuss exactly what happened to this woman point by point.
6. How did Jesus treat this woman?
7. Contrast the way Jesus handles this situation to the way you see our culture handling cultural issues.
8. Who did Jesus come for?

KEY POINT: Jesus said, "I did not come to call the righteous to repentance but sinners," (Matthew 9:13, Mark 2:17, Luke 5:32).

9. What is the Living Water that Jesus offers? To whom is it available? Do you think most Christians tap into the power of the Holy Spirit living within them?
10. Life with the Holy Spirit has the qualities of love, joy, and peace. When you lack these qualities, if you have a drink of the water that Jesus gives; you can immediately

quench your thirst -- again and again and again. Are you tapping into this water?

KEY POINT: Jesus is the wellspring of eternal life!

11. Christians can at times get so zealous for speaking the TRUTH we forget the 'IN LOVE' part. Discuss some of the tough issues in speaking truth IN LOVE.
 12. The end of this story is touching, this woman is so excited she loses her fear and runs to tell everyone she can about who she has found and that she has been made new. How often do you feel that kind of excitement about knowing Jesus?
 13. Why do you think that they listened to her?
- KEY POINT: God alone can fill us up!**
14. What was the end result of this encounter?
 15. This story of taking something as simple as water and using it to transform a life for Jesus, relates to digging wells in Brazil. How?

READ: Revelation 7:9

16. Can clean water lead to spiritual water?
17. Shouldn't we all be excited about this amazing mission God has given us a part in?
