This is what Jesus cried out at the Feast of Tabernacles. This festival or celebration lasted seven days in which the people would live in booths that they made. The eighth day was a holy convocation in remembrance of what God had done and what He was going to do someday in the future for His people. They would remember and thank God for His provision in the wilderness of Sinai. They would thank God for the harvest and the atonement. Many sacrifices were made, and special rites were observed. There was water from the pool of Siloam and torches giving light too. It was a great occasion and thousands of people would be there. **John 1:14.**

John 7:37 The great day of the feast. Jesus stood and cried out. IF anyone is thirsty, let him come to Me and drink. Every morning for the first seven days, with trumpets sounding, water from the pool of Siloam would be brought up to the temple. It was poured out in the temple as a libation or a drink offering to God. **John 4:10,13-14, John 1:33.**

John 7:38 He who believes in Me. Rivers of living waters. **Isaiah 41:18**, **Isaiah 43:19**, **Isaiah 44:3**, **Isaiah 55:1**, **Isaiah 58:11**. Living waters poured into the spiritual deserts of the land and into empty dry souls. This water brings life!

John 7:39 Jesus spoke of the Holy Spirit who was to come for those that believe in Him. When Jesus ascended, the Holy Spirit descended at Pentecost. **Joel 2:28, Matthew 3:11.**

John 8:12 I am the Light of the world and the Light of life. John 1:4, John 12:35-36
