3 Not only that. The Lord will hold you in His hand for all to see as a crown for a King.

4 These are names the Lord gave them and their land in their rebellion against Him and His Law. In that day, My delight is in her and your land will be married to Him. **Numbers 35:33-34.**

5 Just like a young man marries a virgin. A virgin is pure. Jerusalem and the land will be cleansed, pure. The bridegroom rejoices. She is pure, unblemished and she is now claimed and taken by him. Now God will rejoice over her. The land will be cleansed, and righteousness and salvation will go forth from Jerusalem.

6 So God appoints watchmen to call on the Lord and pray day and night for Jerusalem. As believers we should be praying for Israel and Jerusalem. **Psalm 122:6.**

7 Give Him no rest until He responds, until He moves, and Jerusalem is a praise in the earth. God's people should be bombarding Him with cries and prayers until Jerusalem is a praise in the earth. **Zechariah 14:9.**
