WHAT IT TEACHES

- 1. Opportunities are often accompanied by obstacles and opposition. (13:28-29)
 - a. "Open doors don't necessarily mean easy paths."
- 2. If you look at the "giants" rather than God, you'll inevitably be paralyzed by fear and plagued by inadequacies. (13:33)
 - a. The Story of David (1 Sam. 17:45-46)
- 3. There will always be those who say, "You can't," but thank God for those who say, "You can!" (13:30-31)

- **4.** The unbelief of a few spreads like a malignant, aggressive cancer. (14:1-3)
- 5. Those that choose to believe God are frequently in the minority.
- 6. Following God means moving forward, not retreating into the past. (14:4)
- 7. It's the people that trust God who are blessed to witness the power of God.
