

A SCRIPTURAL GUIDE OF HOW TO PRAY FOR OUR CHILDREN

- 1. Experiencing God's Love: May they encounter the depth of God's love through the sacrificial gift of Jesus Christ (Romans 5:8).
- 2. Trusting in Christ: May they place their trust in Jesus as their Savior (2 Timothy 3:15).
- **3. Wholehearted Commitment:** May they live a life fully devoted to Jesus Christ (Romans 12:1-2).
- **4. Godly Hatred for Sin:** May they develop a righteous aversion to sin (Psalm 97:10).
- **5. Accountability and Correction:** May they be held accountable when they err (Psalm 119:71, 119:67, 94:12).
- **6. Protection from Evil:** May they find spiritual, emotional, physical, and financial protection from the evil one (John 17:15; 1 Peter 5:8).
- 7. Respect for Authority: May they honor those in positions of authority (Romans 13:1).
- **8. Choosing Right Friends:** May they desire wholesome friendships and be shielded from harmful associations (1 Corinthians 15:33; Proverbs 1:10).
- **9. Guidance in Relationships:** May they avoid unsuitable partners and be preserved for the right one (1 Corinthians 6:15).

- **10. Purity Until Marriage:** May they and their future spouse maintain purity until marriage (1 Corinthians 6:13-20).
- 11. Learning Humility: May God teach them the virtue of humility (James 4:6; 1 Samuel 15:22-23).
- **12. A Teachable Spirit:** May they remain open to learning and correction (Proverbs 12:1; 13:18; 21:11; 29:1).
- **13. Guided Steps:** May their paths align with God's way and will (Psalm 19:7-11).
- **14. Impactful Purpose:** May God use them significantly for His glory and purposes (Proverbs 16:9).
- **15. Parental Commitment:** May we entrust our children to God daily, seeking to be the best parents we can be (Job 1:5).
