
The Four Gospels Record About 339 Questions Asked By Jesus

 2) To Nurture Deeper Conversations and Relationships
- 3) To Encourage People to come to their Own Conclusions, and Reveal Their Needs,
- 4) To Build FAITH and Draw People into a more Personal Understanding of Truth
 5) To Draw Out What Was Really In Their Hearts

John 5:1-9 (NKJV)

1 After this there was a feast of the Jews, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem.
2 Now there is in Jerusalem by the Sheep Gate a pool, which is called in Hebrew,
Bethesda, having five porches. 3 In these lay a great multitude of sick people, blind, lame,
paralyzed, waiting for the moving of the water. 4 For an angel went down at a certain time
into the pool and stirred up the water; then whoever stepped in first, after the stirring of the water,
was made well of whatever disease he had.

5 Now a certain man was there who had an infirmity thirty-eight years.
6 When Jesus saw him lying there, and knew that he already had been in that condition a long time, He said to him, "DO YOU WANT TO BE MADE WELL?"
7 The sick man answered Him, "Sir, I have no man to put me into the pool when the water is stirred up; but while I am coming, another steps down before me."

Introduction

In John 5, Jesus meets a man that has been lame for 38 years... Jesus shows up and asks this man a simple but intriguing question DO YOU WANT TO BE MADE WHOLE?

For Many people there should be an OBVIOUS ANSWER, "YES"
For Many people there would not be a doubt about if they wanted to be made whole....

But Jesus Asked The Question....

DO YOU WANT TO BE MADE WHOLE?

Jesus Knows That This Man's Ailment Is Not Just Physical He Looks Beyond His Physical Affliction and Sees A Deeper Issue

The Same Question Could Be Asked Of Us Tonight How Bad To We Want To Change? Do We Really Want To Change?

The question challenges individuals to consider if they are truly ready to give up their current circumstances and face the personal effort and commitment required for a life of wholeness.

Principle #1 The Question Is Personal

John 5:3-7

3 In these lay a multitude of invalids—blind, lame, and paralyzed.
5 One man was there who had been an invalid for thirty-eight years.
6 When Jesus saw him lying there and knew that HE had already been there a long time, he said to HIM,
"DO YOU want to be made whole?"

7 The sick man answered him, "Sir, I HAVE NO ONE to put me into the pool when the water is stirred up, and while I am going ANOTHER STEPS down before me."

Jesus Did Not Come To Heal Everyone ~ He Shows Up For ONE MAN He Chooses This One Man As A Visible Demonstration Of His Power...

Although Everyone Has Issues, Jesus Comes To Deal With Him On This Day Many People Are Looking Around At Everyone's Issues And Magnifying Their Misery

Jesus Says, What Can I Do FOR YOU!!!

YOU HAVE BEEN CHOSEN FOR A POWERFUL DEMONSTRATION BUT YOU ARE CONCERNED ABOUT OTHERS ~~

The Question Goes Beyond His Physical Dysfunction To HIS PERSONAL DEPENDENCE

Principle #1 The Question Is Personal

John 5:3-7

6....he said to HIM, "DO YOU want to be made whole?"
7 The sick man answered him, "Sir, I HAVE NO ONE to put me into the pool when the water is stirred up, and while I am going ANOTHER STEPS down before me."

The Question Goes Beyond His Physical Dysfunction To HIS PERSONAL DEPENDENCE

He Is In The Presence Of Jesus ~ But Focused On Other Solutions

Many People Are FOCUSED On Seeking Other Solutions

While Praying and Coming To Church

Their Bodies Are In Church ~ But Their Hope and Trust Is In Other Solutions

We Often Get Caught Up In Methods and Systems Instead Of Hearing/Heeding The Word Of God

The System Will Always Produce Excuses and Explanations
HE HAS AN OPPORTUNITY TO HAVE A PERSONAL ENCOUNTER

The Question Reveals His Dependence On A Systematic Solution

Principle #2 The Question Challenges His Personal Desire John 5:5-6

5 Now a certain man was there who had an infirmity thirty-eight years.
6 When Jesus saw him lying there, and knew that he already had been in that condition a long time,
He said to him, "Do you WANT TO BE made well?"

The Question Goes Beyond His Physical Dysfunction To HIS PERSONAL DESIRE

Jesus Understands That The Load And The Length Of Your Circumstance Can Affect Your Desire

He Had An Infirmity ~ He Was Lame ~ Unable To Move ~ Unable To Do For Himself He Had Been In This Condition For 38 Years...

Many People Can Maintain Their Desire For A Few Weeks, A Few Months, Maybe A Few Years

But There Comes A Point When You Become Sick and Tired Of Being Sick and Tired...

The Enemy Begins To Attack Your Desire To Function

The Enemy Begins To Attack Your Desire To Excel

Eventually You Accept The Dysfunction As "NORMAL"

Principle #2 The Question Challenges His Personal Desire John 5:5-6

5 Now a certain man was there who had an infirmity thirty-eight years.
6 When Jesus saw him lying there, and knew that he already had been in that condition a long time,
He said to him, "Do you WANT TO BE made well?"

Eventually Spiritual Complacency Begins To Set In If you are not careful, you will find yourself just going through the motion If you are not careful, you find yourself in a state of stagnation in your spirit

Zephaniah 1:12 (NLT)

12 "I will search with lanterns in Jerusalem's darkest corners to punish those who sit COMPLACENT in their sins. They think the Lord will do nothing to them, EITHER GOOD OR BAD.

Revelation 3:15-16 (NIV)

15 I know your deeds, that you are NEITHER COLD NOR HOT. I wish you were either one or the other!

16 So, because you are lukewarm--neither hot nor cold--I am about to spit you out of my mouth.

Principle #2 The Question Challenges His Personal Desire The Desire Can Turn Into Unbelief

Mark 9:20-24 (NLT)

20 So they brought the boy. But when the evil spirit saw Jesus, it threw the child into a violent convulsion, and he fell to the ground, writhing and foaming at the mouth.

21 "HOW LONG HAS THIS BEEN HAPPENING?" Jesus asked the boy's father.

He replied, "Since he was a little boy.

22 The spirit often throws him into the fire or into water, trying to kill him.

HAVE MERCY ON US AND HELP US, IF YOU CAN."

23 "What do you mean, 'If I can'?" Jesus asked. "Anything is possible if a person believes." 24 The father instantly cried out, "I DO BELIEVE, BUT HELP ME OVERCOME MY UNBELIEF!"

The Length and The Load Can Affect Your Belief In The One Who Is Able Maintain Your Desire For Change ~ For Better ~ For More

Luke 8:43-48 ~ Woman With Issue of Blood For 12 Years ~ Pressed Her Way Through Crowd Mark 10:46-52 ~ Blind Bartimaeus <mark>Kept Hollering</mark> Until He Got His Attention Genesis 32 ~ Jacob wrestles all night with angel ~ Not Going To Let You Go UNTIL YOU BLESS ME

Principle #3

YOU MUST TRUST THAT GOD HAS AN APPOINTED TIME FOR YOUR BREAKTHROUGH John 9:1-3 (NLT)

1 As Jesus was walking along, he saw a man who had been blind from birth.

2 "Rabbi," his disciples asked him, "why was this man born blind? Was it because of his own sins or his parents' sins?" 3 "It was not because of his sins or his parents' sins," Jesus answered.

"This happened so the power of God could be seen IN HIM.

Principle #3

The Question Challenges His Personal Development

Notice The Power Of God's Word

Jesus Asked, Do You Want To Be Made Whole..... He Responds With Excuses....
The Word Goes Forth Without A Correct Answer....And Without A Demonstration Of Personal Faith

Vs. 8 says, RISE, TAKE UP YOU BED AND WALK

Isaiah 55:10-11 (NLT)

10 "The rain and snow come down from the heavens and stay on the ground to water the earth.

They cause the grain to grow, producing seed for the farmer and bread for the hungry.

11 IT IS THE SAME WITH MY WORD. I SEND IT OUT, and it always produces fruit.

IT WILL ACCOMPLISH ALL I WANT IT TO, and it will prosper everywhere I send it.

God's Word Will Change Your Situation ~ It Just Requires Obedience This Man Obeyed The Word And Didn't Know Who Jesus Was...

How Much More Would The Word Do In Our Lives If We Believed and Obeyed!!!

1) He Did Not Have Knowledge Of Jesus Christ
2) He Has A Sin Issue

He Didn't Know What He Needed ~ But Jesus Knew His Problem Was Beyond Physical Dysfunction

Jesus' Desire Was To Make Him Whole.... Not Make Him Walk
