

Can You Imagine Having Your Weakness Exposed? Is It A Good Thing To Be Exposed?

I Have Discovered That God Specializes In Orchestrating Situations
That Exposes Our Deficiencies.

Unlike Humans, God doesn't expose weaknesses to embarrass or condemn, BUT TO HEAL, STRENGTHEN, AND MATURE US.

Deuteronomy 8:2-3 (NIV)

2 Remember how the Lord your God led you all the way in the desert these forty years, to humble you and to test you in order to know what was in your heart, whether or not you would keep his commands.

3 He humbled you, causing you to hunger and then feeding you with manna, which neither you nor your fathers had known, to teach you that man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of the Lord.

The wilderness wasn't punishment — IT WAS REVELATION.

God uses situations to uncover what's hidden SO He can transform your weakness into strength.

The Big Idea 21) How Long Has This Been Happening TO HIM?

Exposure Is Necessary...SO THAT GET VICTORY IN THE AREAS THAT ARE NOT VISIBLE

Upon Observation, THE SON NEEDS SOME HELP ~ THE SON NEEDS FIXING

GOD ALLOWS ~ GOD ARRANGES ONE SITUATION
That Reveals Some Struggles That Are Not Visible

Notice The Struggle of the Disciples Mark 9:14-18 (ESV)

14 And when they came to the disciples, they saw a great crowd around them, and scribes arguing with them. 15 And immediately all the crowd, when they saw him, were greatly amazed and ran up to him and greeted him.

16 And he asked them, "What are you arguing about with them?"

17 And someone from the crowd answered him, "Teacher, I brought my son to you, for he has a spirit that makes him mute. 18 And whenever it seizes him, it throws him down, and he foams and grinds his teeth and becomes rigid.

So, I asked your disciples to cast it out, and THEY WERE NOT ABLE....

The Disciples Had Been Given Power To Deal With Spirits

Mark 6:7;12-13 (ESV)

7 And he called the twelve and began to send them out two by two, and GAVE THEM AUTHORITY OVER THE UNCLEAN SPIRITS.

12 So they went out and proclaimed that people should repent.

13 And they cast out many demons and anointed with oil many who were sick and healed them.

At One Time They Possessed Power To Perform
At One Time They Demonstrated Power Over The Enemy
BUT TODAY ~ THEY ARE INEFFECTIVE and UNPRODUCTIVE

Exposed In Front Of An Audience ~ vs. 14 ~ A GREAT CROWD AROUND THEM

Notice The Struggle of the Disciples Mark 9:14-18 (ESV)

18 So, I asked your disciples to cast it out, and THEY WERE NOT ABLE....

TODAY ~ THEY ARE INEFFECTIVE and UNPRODUCTIVE

With The Naked Eye ~ They Appear To Be The Same Powerful Followers of God Divine Sovereignty Presents An Orchestrated Opportunity To Reveal The Level/Lack Of Their Power QUESTION: HOW LONG HAS HE BEEN LIKE THIS?

THE SAME QUESTION COULD BE ASKED OF THE DISCIPLES

Judges 16:20 (NLT)

20 Then she cried out, "Samson! The Philistines have come to capture you!" When he woke up, he thought, "I will do as before and shake myself free." But he didn't realize the Lord had left him.

There Is A Danger Of ASSUMING YOU HAVE AUTHORITY To Make A Difference This Text Reminds Us That God Arranges Opportunities For Us To Demonstrate Our Power

With All The Chaos, Confusion, and Conflict in our Community With All The Disease, Destruction and Discouragement in our Community

When Was The Last Time You Demonstrated Your Power

Notice The Struggle of the Disciples Mark 9:14-18 (ESV)

18 So, I asked your disciples to cast it out, and THEY WERE NOT ABLE....

How To Stay Productive and Effective 2 Peter 1:5-8 (NIV)

5 For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; 6 and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; 7 and to godliness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love.

8 For IF you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being INEFFECTIVE AND UNPRODUCTIVE in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Don't Settle For Having The Reputation Without A Demonstration

Matthew 17:19-20 (ESV)

19 Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, "Why could we not cast it out?"
20 He said to them, "Because of your little faith. For truly, I say to you, if you have faith like a grain of mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move, and nothing will be impossible for you."

Notice The Struggle of the Father

Matthew 17:14-16 (ESV)

14 And when they came to the crowd, a man came up to him and, kneeling before him, 15 said, "Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic and he suffers terribly.

For often he falls into the fire, and often into the water.

16 And I brought him to your disciples, and they could not heal him."

Luke 9:38 (ESV)

38 And behold, a man from the crowd cried out, "Teacher, I beg you to look at my son, for he is my only child.

This Father Appears To Have It All Together

Religious Appearance, Religious In Asking He Is Concerned, He Is Compassionate, He Is Caring He Has Provided For His Son, He Has Protected His Son

It Is Not Until There Is DIALOGUE WITH THE DIVINE, That We Discover His Own Deficiency

Why Did Jesus Deal With The Unbelief Before The Healing Of The Son Mark 6:5-6 (NLT)

5 And BECAUSE OF THEIR UNBELIEF, HE COULDN'T DO ANY MIGHTY MIRACLES AMONG THEM except to place his hands on a few sick people and heal them.

6 And he was amazed at their unbelief.

Unbelief limits what Jesus could do, not because His power failed, but because UNBELIEF CLOSED PEOPLE'S HEARTS TO RECEIVE IT.

Warning:

Don't Allow The Atmosphere of Unbelief TO BLOCK THE POWER OF GOD IN YOUR LIFE.

Notice The Struggle of the Son

Mark 9:17-18 (ESV)

17 And someone from the crowd answered him, "Teacher, I brought my son to you, for he has a spirit that makes him mute. 18 And whenever it seizes him, it throws him down, and he foams and grinds his teeth and becomes rigid.

Mark 9:20-22 (ESV)

20 And they brought the boy to him. And when the spirit saw him, immediately it convulsed the boy, and he fell on the ground and rolled about, foaming at the mouth.

21 And Jesus asked his father, "How long has this been happening to him?"

And he said, "From childhood. 22 And it has often cast him into fire and into water, to destroy him.

Pushed Others Into The Presence Of Christ
