His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.*

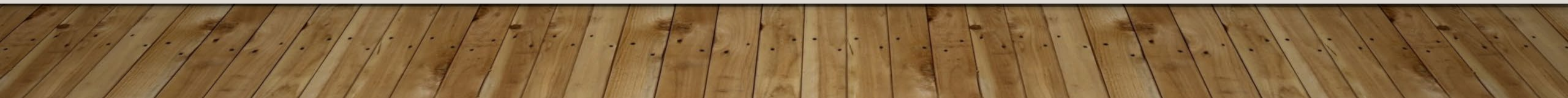
8 *And now, dear brothers and sisters, one final thing. FIX YOUR THOUGHTS on what

Colossians 3:15

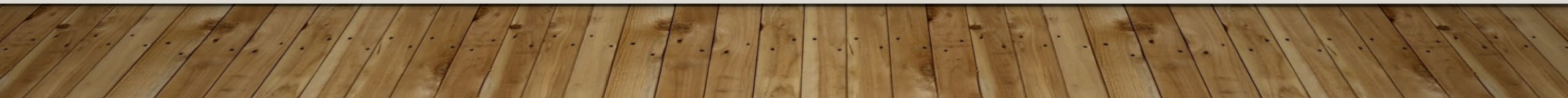
15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful.
