Introduction

OThe Depression and Bipolar Support Alliance {DBSA} says that Depression is a treatable medical condition related to how our brains work, especially how our brains process information, emotions, and stress. It's not a character flaw or a sign of personal weakness. Just like you can't "WISH AWAY" diabetes, heart disease, of or any other significant illness, you can't make depression go away by trying to "SNAP OUT OF IT."

Depression, Anxiety, Grief, and Mental Anguish does not just disappear; they must be DEALT WITH...

There are so may things that rob us of our INNER PEACE. Therefore, our MENTAL HEALTH MUST BE

A PRIORITY... MAINTAINING INNER PEACE MUST BE INTENTIONAL

Research shows there is a CONSTANT BATTLE for INNER PEACE AND MENTAL HEALTH. During this study of the Struggle Is Real, I was introduced to a new word, "PSYCHOMACHY". In Greek, psyche denotes the mind and mache a struggle or fight, so a "Psychomachy" is the effort to cope with mental problems—addiction, anxiety, explosive anger, and so on—and overcome them. It is A BATTLE for THE SOUL IT IS A BATTLE BETWEEN VIRTUES AND VICES...

There is a Constant Battle Between Inner Peace and Fleshly Pleasure... You must decide if you are going to Fight For Your Peace or Forfeit Your Peace...

Famous Rapper Nipsey Hussle said on his album Victory Lap....
"Would You rather be at war with yourself and at peace with the world,
or AT PEACE WITH YOURSELF AND AT WAR WITH THE WORLD."

The Reality Of The Struggle

Romans 7:15-25 (NLT)

15 I don't really understand myself, for I WANT TO DO WHAT IS RIGHT, BUT I DON'T DO IT. INSTEAD, I DO WHAT I HATE. 16 But if I know that what I am doing is wrong, this shows that I agree that the law is good. 17 So I am not the one doing wrong; it is sin living in me that does it. 18 And I KNO THAT NOTHING GOOD LIVES IN ME, that is, in my sinful nature. I WANT TO DO WHAT IS RIGHT, BUT I CAN'T. 19 I WANT TO DO WHAT IS GOOD, BUT I DON'T. I DON'T WANT TO DO WHAT IS WRONG, BUT I **DO IT ANYWAY.** 20 But if I do what I don't want to do, I am not really the one doing wrong; it is sin living in me that does it. 21 I have discovered THIS PRINCIPLE OF LIFE—that WHEN I WANT TO DO WHAT IS RIGHT, I INEVITABLY DO WHAT IS WRONG. 22 I love God's law with all my heart. 23 But THERE IS ANOTHER POWER WITHIN ME THAT IS AT WAR WITH MY MIND. This power makes me a slave to the sin that is still within me. 24 Oh, WHAT A MISERABLE PERSON I AM! Who will free me from this life that is dominated by sin and death? 25 Thank God! THE ANSWER IS IN JESUS CHRIST OUR LORD. So you see how it is: In my mind I really want to obey God's law, but because of my sinful nature I am a slave to sin.

In The Midst Of The War, You May Lose Some Battles

2 Samuel 11:1-5 (NLT)

PIn the spring of the year, when kings normally go out to war, David sent Joab and the Israelite army to fight the Ammonites. They destroyed the Ammonite army and laid siege to the city of Rabbah. However, David stayed behind in Jerusalem. 2 Late one afternoon, after his midday rest, David got out of bed and was walking on the roof of the palace. As he looked out over the city, he noticed a woman of unusual beauty taking a bath. 3 He sent someone to find out who she was, and he was told, "She is Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam and the wife of Uriah the Hittite." 4 Then David sent messengers to get her; and when she came to the palace, he slept with her.. 5 Later, when Bathsheba discovered that she was pregnant, she sent David a message, saying, "I'm pregnant."

2 Samuel 11:6-9 (NLT)

6 Then David sent word to Joab: "Send me Uriah the Hittite." So Joab sent him to David.
7 When Uriah arrived, David asked him how Joab and the army were getting along and how the war was progressing. 8 Then he told Uriah, "Go on home and relax." David even sent a gift to Uriah after he had left the palace. 9 But Uriah didn't go home. He slept that night at the palace entrance with the king's palace guard.

2 Samuel 11:13 (NLT)

13 Then David invited him to dinner and got him drunk. But even then he couldn't get Uriah to go home to his wife. Again he slept at the palace entrance with the king's palace guard.

2 Samuel 11:14-15 (NLT

14 So the next morning David wrote a letter to Joab and gave it to Uriah to deliver.

15 The letter instructed Joab, "Station Uriah on the front lines where the battle is fiercest.

Then pull back so that he will be killed."

Resources That Allow Restoration

David lived in depression, discouragement, and defeat because of his unconfessed sin. The consequences of his wrong choices weighed on him emotionally and physically.

Psalm 31:9-10 (NLT)

9 Have mercy on me, LORD, for I AM IN DISTRESS. Tears blur my eyes. MY BODY AND SOUL ARE WITHERING AWAY. 10 I AM DYING FROM GRIEF; my years are shortened by sadness. SIN HAS DRAINED MY STRENGTH; I AM WASTING AWAY FROM WITHIN.

Psalm 13:2 (NLT)

2 HOW LONG MUST I STRUGGLE WITH ANGUISH IN MY SOUL, with SORROW IN MY HEART EVERY DAY?

Psalm 38:3-6 (NLT)

3 Because of your anger, MY WHOLE BODY IS SICK; my health is broken because of my sins. 4 My guilt overwhelms me— it is a burden too heavy to bear. 5 My wounds fester and stink because of my foolish sins. 6 I am bent over and racked with pain. All day long I walk around filled with grief.

Psalm 6:6-7 (NLT)

6 I am worn out from sobbing. All night I flood my bed with weeping, drenching it with my tears.

Psalm 42:4-6 (NIV)

4 THESE THINGS I REMEMBER AS I POUR OUT MY SOUL: how I used to go with the multitude, leading the procession to the house of God, with shouts of joy and thanksgiving among the festive throng.

5 Why are you downcast, O my soul? Why so disturbed within me?

Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise him, my Savior and my God.

Psalm 142:7 (ESV)

7 Bring me out of prison, THAT I MAY GIVE THANKS TO YOUR NAME!

Psalm 51:2-3, 10-12 (ESV)

2 Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin! 3 For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me. 10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. 11 Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from me. 12 Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit.
