


Day Fourteen Giving Expectantly

Romans 15:4


For whatever was written before, was written for our learning, that we, through the endurance and comfort of the scriptures **MIGHT HAVE EXPECTATION**

EXPECTATION is the attitude that brings into reality the answer that we need.

Psalms 5:3 (NIV)

3 In the morning, O Lord, you hear my voice; in the morning I lay my requests before you and **WAIT IN EXPECTATION**.

One aspect of **BELIEVING EXPECTANTLY** is keeping your focus on the promise, not the circumstance

Malachi 3:10

Proverbs 3:9-10 (NIV)



2 Corinthians 9:6 (NIV)

Matthew 6:33 (NKJV)

33 But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness... **YOU SAID** and all these things shall be added to you.

1 Timothy 6:17 (NASB)

17 Instruct those who are rich in this present world not to be conceited or to fix their hope on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly supplies us with all things to enjoy.

Romans 4:18-21 (NASB)

18 In hope against hope **he believed**, so that he might become a father of many nations according to that which had been spoken, "So shall your descendants be."



Psalms 130:5 (TLB)

5 That is why I wait expectantly, trusting God to help, for he has promised.
