

# It Is A Question That Tests Our Faith

Many Will Say, Pastor There Is Nothing About FAITH In The Question...
"Do You Believe That I Am Able To Do This?
But Notice What Jesus Says After The Touch

"According To Your Faith... Let It Be Done To You"

Faith and Believing Are Connected

BELIEF is the mental acceptance that something IS TRUE.

It's the starting point.

We Must First Believe That God Exists and That God Can Do What He Says

Believing Is Good But It Is Not Enough

James 2:19 (NLT)

19 You say you have faith, for you believe that there is one God. Good for you!

Even the demons believe this, and they tremble in terror.

Belief alone RECOGNIZES TRUTH, but it may not yet involve TRUST OR ACTION Rich Young Ruler Believed Jesus had the keys to eternal life.... But Was not willing to trust his instructions

#### Introduction

The Connection Between Believing and Faith

Faith is BELIEF that moves from the mind to the heart and hands.
IT MEANS RELYING ON WHAT YOU BELIEVE ENOUGH TO ACT ON IT.

FAITH trusts God's Power and His Promises even when the outcome isn't visible.

Belief says, "I think God can."

Faith says, "I'm stepping forward because I KNOW HE WILL."

#### Hebrews 11:6

"Without FAITH it is impossible to please God, for whoever comes to Him must BELIEVE that He exists and that He rewards those who diligently seek Him." —

So, BELIEVING recognizes God's existence; FAITH depends on God's Power.

**BELIEVING** recognizes Jesus' ability. **FAITH** activates His power in my life

Mark 9:23 — "If you can believe, all things are possible." {BUT MAYBE NOT FOR ME}

Belief begins the journey; faith carries it through.

The Connection Between Believing and Faith

#### PRACTICAL EXAMPLE

Belief is saying, "I think the chair will hold me."

Faith is sitting down in it.

#### Theological Example

Belief is saying, "I think God Is Able To Pour Me Out A Blessing, Because the Bible Says It Faith is Tithing Even When Things Are Tight Financially

#### Biblical Example

Thomas Believed Jesus was real; He walked With Him For 3 Years and Experienced His Existence Thomas says in John 20, "Unless I See The Nail Prints, I will not believe"

Intellectually You Really Believe That He Is Able
But Are You Demonstrating A Faith That Supports What You Say You Believe

#### One Writer Says...

True faith walks when sight is dim, hopes when the future is unclear, and obeys when the path is uncertain

*Matthew 9:27-28 (ESV)* 

27 And as Jesus passed on from there, two blind men followed him, crying aloud, "Have mercy on us, Son of David."

28 When he entered the house, the blind men came to him, and Jesus said to them, "Do you believe that I am able to do this?" They said to him, "Yes, Lord."

Notice the Timing Of The Question
After They Had Demonstrated A PERSISTENT FAITH

Even though they can't see, they keep moving toward Him — a picture of faith in action. They believe He can heal them, and that belief pushes them to keep pursuing Him UNTIL THEY REACH HIS PRESENCE.

Jesus Is A Rewarded Of Those Who DILIGENTLY SEEK HIM

Their Persistence Leads To A Personal Encounter
They Had The Correct Declaration ~ "Have Mercy on us, Son of David"
But Jesus Is Seeking Determination
They Would Not Give Up UNTIL.....

When You Read This Entire Chapter... There Are Several Examples Of Faith and Determination

*Matthew 9:2 (ESV)* 

2 And behold, some people brought to him a paralytic, lying on a bed. And when Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Take heart, my son; your sins are forgiven."

6 he then said to the paralytic—"Rise, pick up your bed and go home."

*Mark 2:4 (ESV)* 

4 And when they could not get near him because of the crowd, they removed the roof above him, and when they had made an opening, they let down the bed on which the paralytic lay.

Persistent Faith Is Creative and Courageous Persistent Faith Encounters and Overcomes Barriers

Do You Have A Faith That Falters Before The Finish? What Does It Take For You To Quit; Give Up; Give In....

Often God Has To Allow Your Situation To Become Desperate
To Increase Your Determination

When You Read This Entire Chapter... There Are Several Examples Of Faith and Determination  $Matthew\ 9:20-22\ (ESV)$ 

20 And behold, a woman who had suffered from a discharge of blood for twelve years came up behind him and touched the fringe of his garment, 21 for she said to herself, "If I only touch his garment, I will be made well."

22 Jesus turned, and seeing her he said, "Take heart, daughter; YOUR FAITH HAS MADE YOU WELL." And instantly the woman was made well.

She Believed That Jesus Could Heal Her ~ She Believed That Jesus Was Able
She Persevered Through The Crowd ~ She Believed Change Was Possible
Faith connects human need to divine power

#### *Matthew 9:18 (ESV)*

18 While he was saying these things to them, behold, a ruler came in and knelt before him, saying, "My daughter has just died, but come and lay your hand on her, and she will live."

He Believed Jesus Could Heal ~ He Believed Jesus Had The Power Mark 5:35-36 (ESV)

35 While he was still speaking, there came from the ruler's house some who said, "Your daughter is dead. Why trouble the Teacher any further?" 36 But overhearing what they said, Jesus said to the ruler of the synagogue, "DO NOT FEAR, ONLY BELIEVE."

# Faith Must Be Fully Persuaded

Matthew 9:28 (ESV)

28 When he entered the house, the blind men came to him, and Jesus said to them, "DO YOU BELIEVE THAT I AM ABLE TO DO THIS?" They said to him, "YES, LORD."

# Faith opens the door for DIVINE ABILITY to enter HUMAN IMPOSSIBILITY.

It was impossible for them to regain their own sight... So, they had to demonstrate their faith in the One Who Was Able

# Jesus Was Convinced That They Were Fully Persuaded In The Promise

Isaiah 35:2-5

The Lord will display his glory... 3 With this news, strengthen those who have tired hands, and encourage those who have weak knees....4 Say to those with fearful hearts, "Be strong, and do not fear, for your God is coming to destroy your enemies. He is coming to save you." And when he comes, he will open the eyes of the blind and unplug the ears of the deaf.

#### Isaiah 42:6-7

"I will take hold of your hand. I will keep you and will make you to be a covenant for the people and a light for the Gentiles, 7 to open eyes that are blind, to free captives from prison and to release from the dungeon those who sit in darkness.

#### Isaiah 29:18

In that day the deaf will hear the words of the scroll, and out of gloom and darkness the eyes of the blind will see.

GOD'S WORD WAS THE FOUNDATION OF THEIR FAITH

# Faith Must Be Fully Persuaded

Matthew 9:28 (ESV)

## Biblical Example

Romans 4:19-21 (NIV)

19 Without weakening in his faith, he faced the fact that his body was as good as dead--since he was about a hundred years old--and that Sarah's womb was also dead.

20 Yet he did not waver through unbelief regarding the promise of God,

BUT WAS STRENGTHENED IN HIS FAITH and gave glory to God,

21 BEING FULLY PERSUADED THAT GOD HAD POWER TO DO WHAT HE HAD PROMISED.

Fully Persuaded Is Complete Confidence In God's Ability To Do What He Promised God Gives Promises In His Word.... IF YOU DO THIS ... THEN I Will Do That

The Reason Why We Don't Do It ~ We Are Not Fully Persuaded That God Will DO What He Promised

Fully Persuaded Is Not Shaken By God's Timing
Fully Persuaded Is Not Shaken By The Magnitude Of the Problem

# Faith Will Be Rewarded Matthew 9:29 (ESV)

29 THEN he touched their eyes, saying, "According to your faith be it done to you."

BELIEVING OPENS THE MIND TO THE POSSIBILITY ~ FAITH OPENS THE DOOR TO GOD'S POWER

#### FAITH EXPECTS A RESPONSE FROM GOD

Time and Trouble Diminishes Our Expectation, But Does Not Stop Spiritual Routine Acts 12:5; 14-16 (ESV)

5 So Peter was kept in prison, but earnest prayer for him was made to God by the church.

14 Recognizing Peter's voice, in her joy she did not open the gate but ran in and reported that Peter was standing at the gate. 15 They said to her, "You are out of your mind." But she kept insisting that it was so, and they kept saying, "It is his angel!"

16 But Peter continued knocking, and when they opened, they saw him and were amazed.

#### Hebrews 11:6

6 And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that HE REWARDS THOSE WHO DILIGENTLY SEEK HIM.

The reward is not for casual seekers but for those who intensely pursue God God rewards, blesses, and honors those who trust and seek Him.
