*If You Don't Have Enough To Tithe...
Check One Of These Principles*

Withholding ~ Proverbs 11:24 (ESV)

*24 One gives freely, yet grows all the richer;
another withholds what he should give, and only suffers want.*

Sleep Too Much ~ Proverbs 20:13 (NLT)

*13 If you love sleep, you will end in poverty. Keep your eyes open,
and there will be plenty to eat!*

Refuse To Follow Instructions ~ Proverbs 13:18 (ESV)

*18 Poverty and disgrace come to him who ignores instruction,
but whoever heeds reproof is honored.*

Chasing Fantasies ~ Proverbs 28:19 (NLT)

*19 A hard worker has plenty of food,
but a person who chases fantasies ends up in poverty.*

Chasing Shortcuts ~ Proverbs 21:5 (NLT)

*5 Good planning and hard work lead to prosperity,
but hasty shortcuts lead to poverty.*

Day Seven Meditation

Genesis 14:18-20 (NKJV)

18 Then Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine; he was the priest of God Most High. 19 And he blessed him and said: "Blessed be Abram of God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth;
20 And blessed be God Most High, Who has delivered your enemies into your hand."
And he gave him a tithe of all.

Genesis 28:20-22 (NLT)

20 Then Jacob made this vow: "If God will indeed be with me and protect me on this journey, and if he will provide me with food and clothing, 21 and if I return safely to my father's home, then the Lord will certainly be my God. 22 And this memorial pillar I have set up will become a place for worshiping God,
and I will present to God a tenth of everything he gives me."

Leviticus 27:30 (ESV)

30 *"Every tithe of the land*, whether of the seed of the land or of the fruit of the trees, is the Lord's; *it is holy to the Lord.*

Deuteronomy 14:22 (ESV)

22 *"You shall tithe* all the yield of your seed that comes from the field year by year.

Numbers 18:21 (ESV)

21 "To the Levites *I have given every tithe in Israel* for an inheritance, in return for their service that they do, their service in the tent of meeting...

Deuteronomy 16:17 (ESV)

17 Every man shall *give as he is able*,
according to the blessing of the Lord your God that he has given you.

Proverbs 3:9-10 (ESV)

9 *Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the firstfruits of all your produce*;
10 then your barns will be filled with plenty,
and your vats will be bursting with wine.

2 Corinthians 9:7 (ESV)

7 Each one must *give as he has decided in his heart*,
not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

1 Corinthians 16:2 (ESV)

2 On the first day of every week,
each of you is to put something aside and store it up, as he may prosper...

Matthew 23:23 (ESV)

23 “Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! *For you tithe* mint and dill and cumin, and have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and *faithfulness. These you ought to have done, without neglecting the others.*
