We **can't trust** everything we hear from politicians, preachers, or popular people

But **We Can Trust** The Word of God

2 Timothy 3:16-17 (NLT)

16 All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to **teach us what is true** and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right.

17 God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work.

Numbers 23:19 (NLT)

19 God is not a man, so he does not lie. He is not human, so he does not change his mind.

Has he ever spoken and failed to act? Has he ever promised and not carried it through?

Isaiah 55:11 (NLT)

11 It is the same with MY WORD. I send it out, and it ALWAYS PRODUCES FRUIT.

John 4:46-53 (NIV)

46 Once more he visited Cana in Galilee, where he had turned the water into wine. And there was a certain royal official whose son lay sick at Capernaum. 47 When this man heard that Jesus had arrived in Galilee from Judea, he went to him and begged him to come and heal his son, who was close to death. 48 "Unless you people see miraculous signs and wonders," Jesus told him, "you will never BELIEVE."

49 The royal official said, "Sir, come down before my child dies."

*50 Jesus replied, "YOU MAY GO. YOUR SON WILL LIVE."
THE MAN TOOK JESUS AT HIS WORD AND DEPARTED.*

51 While he was still on the way, his servants met him with the news that his boy was living.

52 When he inquired as to the time when his son got better, they said to him, "The fever left him yesterday at the seventh hour." 53 Then the father realized that this was the exact time at which Jesus had said to him, "Your son will live." SO HE AND ALL HIS HOUSEHOLD BELIEVED.

2 Kings 5:2-12 (NLT)

2 At this time Aramean raiders had invaded the land of Israel, and among their captives was a young girl who had been given to Naaman's wife as a maid. 3 One day the girl said to her mistress, "I wish my master would go to see the prophet in Samaria. He would heal him of his leprosy." 4 So Naaman told the king what the young girl from Israel had said. 5 "Go and visit the prophet," the king of Aram told him. "I will send a letter of introduction for you to take to the king of Israel." So Naaman started out, carrying as gifts 750 pounds of silver, 150 pounds of gold, and ten sets of clothing. 6 The letter to the king of Israel said: "With this letter I present my servant Naaman. I want you to heal him of his leprosy." 9 So Naaman went with his horses and chariots and waited at the door of Elisha's house. 10 But Elisha sent a messenger out to him with this message: "Go and wash yourself seven times in the Jordan River. Then your skin will be restored, and you will be healed of your leprosy."

11 But Naaman became angry and stalked away. "I thought he would certainly come out to meet me!" he said. "I expected him to wave his hand over the leprosy and call on the name of the LORD his God and heal me! 12 Aren't the rivers of Damascus, better than any of the rivers of Israel? Why shouldn't I wash in them and be healed?" So Naaman turned and went away in a rage.

2 Kings 5:13-15 (NLT)

*13 But his officers tried to reason with him and said, “Sir, if the prophet had told you to do something very difficult, wouldn’t you have done it? So **you should certainly obey him when he says simply, ‘Go and wash and be cured!’**”*

14 So Naaman went down to the Jordan River and dipped himself seven times, as the man of God had instructed him. And his skin became as healthy as the skin of a young child’s, and he was healed!

*15 Then Naaman and his entire party went back to find the man of God. They stood before him, and Naaman said, “**NOW I KNOW** that there is no God in all the world except in Israel.*

*You can **choose** to come up with better ways to do things...*

Luke 18:35-43 (NLT)

35 As Jesus approached Jericho, a blind beggar was sitting beside the road.

36 When he heard the noise of a crowd going past, he asked what was happening.

37 They told him that Jesus the Nazarene was going by. 38 So he began shouting, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!” 39 “Be quiet!” the people in front yelled at him. But he only shouted louder, “Son of David, have mercy on me!” 40 When Jesus heard him, he stopped and ordered that the man be brought to him. As the man came near,

Jesus asked him, 41 “What do you want me to do for you?” “Lord,” he said, “I want to see!”

*42 And Jesus said, “**ALL RIGHT, RECEIVE YOUR SIGHT!** Your faith has healed you.”*

43 Instantly the man could see, and he followed Jesus, praising God. And all who saw it praised God, too.

The Cost Of Comparison

John 9:1-11 (NLT)

1 As Jesus was walking along, he saw a man who had been blind from birth.

2 “Rabbi,” his disciples asked him, “why was this man born blind? Was it because of his own sins or his parents’ sins?” 3 “It was not because of his sins or his parents’ sins,” Jesus answered. “This happened so the power of God could be seen in him. 6 Then he spit on the ground, made mud with the saliva, and spread the mud over the blind man’s eyes. 7 He told him, “Go wash yourself in the pool of Siloam” (Siloam means “sent”).

So the man went and washed and came back seeing!

John 2:1-8 (NIV)

*1 On the third day a wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there, 2 and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. 3 When the wine was gone, Jesus' mother said to him, "They have no more wine." 4 "Dear woman, why do you involve me?" Jesus replied. "My time has not yet come."
5 His mother said to the servants, "**DO WHATEVER HE TELLS YOU.**"
6 Nearby stood six stone water jars, the kind used by the Jews for ceremonial washing, each holding from twenty to thirty gallons.
7 Jesus said to the servants, "**FILL THE JARS WITH WATER**"; *so they filled them to the brim.*
8 Then he told them, "Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet." **THEY DID SO...***

*Notice Mary didn't try to **Solve the Problem...** Directed Them To Jesus {**THE WORD**}*

James 1:2-4

2 Dear brothers and sisters, *when troubles come your way, CONSIDER IT AN OPPORTUNITY FOR GREAT JOY.*

3 For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow.

4 So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, *you will be perfect and complete, needing nothing.*
