So if there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort from love, any participation in the Spirit, any affection and sympathy, ² complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind. ³ Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. ⁴ Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. ⁵ Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, ⁶ who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, ⁷ but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. ⁸ And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. ⁹ Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰ so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. ~ **Philippians 2:1-11**

FIVE PRACTICAL STEPS OF FINDING JOY THROUGH REDUCED CONFLICT AND GREATER UNITY

1. DON'T ACT OUT OF SELFISH AMBITION

Do nothing from <u>selfish ambition</u> or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. ⁴Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. ⁵ Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus. ~ Philippians 2:3-5

2. DON'T ACT OUT IN PRIDE

Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit ~ Philippians 2:3a

- a) Three Symptoms of a spirit of pride:
 - Critical
 - Harshness
 - Longing for attention

This is what the LORD says: "Don't let the wise boast in their wisdom, or the powerful boast in their power, or the rich boast in their riches. ²⁴ But those who wish to boast should boast in this alone: that they truly know me and understand that I am the LORD who demonstrates unfailing love and who brings justice and righteousness to the earth, and that I delight in these things. I, the LORD, have spoken! ~ Jeremiah 9:23-24

3. HUMILITY OF MIND

But in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. ~ Philippines 3b "Humility is not thinking less of yourself – but thinking of your-self less." C.S. Lewis

4. INCREASE CONSIDERATION OF OTHERS

Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. ~ Philippians 2:4

5. THINK LIKE JESUS

You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. ⁶ Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to. ⁷ Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being. When he appeared in human form, ⁸ he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross. ~ Philippians 2:5-8

- a) Jesus had thoughts of...
- Self-denial
- Self-giving
- Self-sacrifice
- Selfless love

⁹ Therefore, God elevated him to the place of highest honor and gave him the name above all other names, ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and every tongue declare that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
