PHILIPPIANS #JOY in our service



I hope in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy to you soon, so that I too may be cheered by news of you. ²⁰ For I have no one like him, who will be genuinely concerned for your welfare. ²¹ For they all seek their own interests, not those of Jesus Christ. ²² But you know Timothy's proven worth, how as a son with a father he has served with me in the gospel. ²³ I hope therefore to send him just as soon as I see how it will go with me, ²⁴ and I trust in the Lord that shortly I myself will come also. ²⁵ I have thought it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus my brother and fellow worker and fellow soldier, and your messenger and minister to my need, ²⁶ for he has been longing for you all and has been distressed because you heard that he was ill. ²⁷ Indeed he was ill, near to death. But God had mercy on him, and not only on him but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow. ²⁸ I am the more eager to send him, therefore, that you may rejoice at seeing him again, and that I may be less anxious. ²⁹ So receive him in the Lord with all joy, and honor such men, ³⁰ for he nearly died for the work of Christ, risking his life to complete what was lacking in your service to me. **~ Philippians 2:19-30**

FIVE QUALITIES GOD IS LOOKING FOR IN MEN (ALL SERVANTS)

1. COMPASSION

But I trust in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy to you shortly, that I also may be encouraged when I know your state. ²⁰ For I have no one like-minded, who will sincerely care for your state. ²¹ For all seek their own, not the things which are of Christ Jesus. ~ Philippians 2:91-21

Let each of you look not only <u>to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.</u>⁵ Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus. ~ Philippians 2:4-5a

But when He saw the multitudes, <u>He was moved with compassion for them</u>, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. ~ Matthew 9:35

2. CONSISTENCY

"But you know <u>his proven character</u>, that as a son with his father he served with me in the gospel." ~ Philippians 2:22

Imitate me, just as I also imitate Christ. ~ 1 Corinthians 11:1

Don't let anyone think less of you because you are young. <u>Be an example to all believers in</u> <u>what you say, in the way you live, in your love, your faith, and your purity.</u> ~ 1 Timothy 4:12

3. COOPERATION

"Yet I considered it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, <u>my brother</u>, <u>fellow worker</u>, and <u>fellow soldier</u>, but your messenger and the one who ministered to my need;" ~ Philippians 2:25

4. COMMITMENT

For indeed he was sick almost unto death; but God had mercy on him, and not only on him but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow. ²⁸ Therefore I sent him the more eagerly, that when you see him again you may rejoice, and I may be less sorrowful." ~ Philippians 2:27-28

For you have been given not only the privilege of trusting in Christ but also the <u>privilege of</u> <u>suffering for him</u>. ~ Philippians 1:29

5. COURAGE

Receive him therefore in the Lord with all gladness, and hold such men in esteem; ³⁰ because for the work of Christ he came close to death, not regarding his life, to supply what was lacking in your service toward me." ~ Philippians 2:29-30
