# PHILIPPIANS #JOY in my relationships

This letter is from Paul and Timothy, slaves of Christ Jesus. I am writing to all of God's holy people in Philippi who belong to Christ Jesus, including the church leaders and deacons. <sup>2</sup> May God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ give you grace and peace. <sup>3</sup> Every time I think of you, I give thanks to my God. 4 Whenever I pray. I make my requests for all of you with joy. 5 for you have been my partners in spreading the Good News about Christ from the time you first heard it until now. 6 And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns. 7 So it is right that I should feel as I do about all of you, for you have a special place in my heart. You share with me the special favor of God, both in my imprisonment and in defending and confirming the truth of the Good News. 8 God knows how much I love you and long for you with the tender compassion of Christ Jesus. 9 I pray that your love will overflow more and more, and that you will keep on growing in knowledge and understanding. 10 For I want you to understand what really matters, so that you may live pure and blameless lives until the day of Christ's return. 11 May you always be filled with the fruit of your salvation—the righteous character produced in your life by Jesus Christ for this will bring much glory and praise to God. ~ Philippians 1:1-11

- A positive book that focuses on joy.

### **Memory Verse:**

"Rejoice in the Lord always. Again, I will say, rejoice!"

#### FOUR PRINCIPALS TO FINDING JOY IN RELATIONSHIP:

#### 1. YOU'VE GOT TO LEARN TO PUT PEOPLE IN YOUR THOUGHTS.

"I thank my God every time I remember you." Philippians 1:3

Paul had...

- Caring thoughts
- Thankful thoughts

The crowd joined in attacking them, and the magistrates tore the garments off them and gave orders to beat them with rods. <sup>23</sup> And when they had inflicted many blows upon them, they threw them into prison, ordering the jailer to keep them safely. <sup>24</sup> Having received this order, he put them into the inner prison and fastened their feet in the stocks. ~ Acts 16:22-24

#### 2. PAUL LOOKED FOR THE POSITIVE IN PEOPLE

#### 3. BE PATIENT WITH THE GROWTH IN PEOPLE

And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ. ~ Philippians 1:6

#### God does a two-fold work in our lives...

#### 1. Salvation – the work God does for us

"8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works, lest anyone should boast." **Ephesians 2:8-9** 

#### 2. Sanctification – the work God does in us

For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases him. ~ Philippians 2:13

<sup>8</sup> For God is my witness, how <u>I yearn for you all with the affection of Christ</u> <u>Jesus</u>. ~ Philippians 1:7-8

#### 4. PUT PEOPLE IN YOUR PRAYERS

And it is my prayer that **your love may abound more and more**, with knowledge and all discernment. ~ Philippines 1:9a

#### A. PRAY FOR PEOPLE'S GROWTH.

So that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love, <sup>18</sup> may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, <sup>19</sup> and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. ~ Ephesians 3: 17-19

#### **B. PRAY FOR PEOPLE TO MAKE GOOD CHOICES.**

And that you will keep on growing in knowledge and understanding. ~ Philippians 1:9b

#### C. PRAY FOR PEOPLE'S CHARACTER.

For I want you to understand what really matters, so that you may live <u>pure</u> and <u>blameless</u> lives until the day of Christ's return. ~ Philippians 1:10

#### D. PRAY FOR PEOPLE TO BE FRUITFUL.

May you always be filled with the fruit of your salvation—the righteous character produced in your life by Jesus Christ—for this will bring much glory and praise to God. ~ Philippians 1:11
