



If I get the Daddy, I'll have the family. If I get the mother, I won't have the family very long... as soon as they get in high school they'll be gone."

Dr. Paige Patterson,

"And that Daddy has got to understand that when he came to Christ he accepted a new role, because he is now the pastor of his household. **And so, somewhere I'd change my approach in a major way.**"

1. Ultimately, discipleship and evangelism is a <u>manhood</u> issue.

2. Men are primary to what rules over a society.

Gen. 3:16; Deut. 6:6-9; Exodus 17:8-16; 1 Corin. 11:3; Eph. 5:22-24; 6:1-4

3. The <u>church</u> is primary to building real men.

Colossians 1:24-29; 1 Timothy 3; Titus 1:5-9

4. Nothing has the power to transform the world more than discipling men.

5. When you minister to a man, you also minister to his wife and children.

Exocus 17:11-12,

And so it was, when Moses held up his hand Israel prevailed; and when he let down his hand Amalek prevailed. But Moses' hands became heavy;

Exocus 17:12,

so they took a stone and put it under him and he sat on it. And Aaron and Hur supported his hands, one on one side, and the other on the other side;

Exocus 17:12,

and his hands were **steady** until the going down of the sun.

Hebrews 12:12-13,

Therefore strengthen the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees, ¹³ and make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be dislocated, but rather be healed.

Nehemiah 6:9,

For they all were trying to make us afraid, saying, "Their hands will be weakened in the work, and it will not be done." Now therefore, O God, strengthen my hands.
