Slide 2 Mentoring - Definition

- Use the life experience of the older, wiser men at your church to lead others towards being allin followers of Jesus (Radical Mentoring website)
- What is an all-in follower of Jesus?
- Someone who gets up when He sees God moving and follows in faith no matter the cost?
- A Christian mentor (discipler/influencer) is someone who does this as he sees God working in other men through the eyes of Christ.

Results of a small survey amongst young Christians 20-30 yr. olds

- Facilitating transformation into the image of Christ. II Cor 3:18
- Taking up where God is already at work and joining in the work. 2 Cor 3:3
- Fulfilling our God gioven part in the body of Christ to obtain mature manhood and the fullness of Christ - Eph. 4: 13
- Pour ourselves into another for Christ. Paul and Timothy I&II Tim.
- Coming alongside a brother, and encouraging them in Christ. Barnabas
- Influencers

Slide 8 Skills of a mentor/discipler/influencer

• Intercessory Prayer - Intentional

"the most direct way to another person's soul is not talking to them – it is talking to Jesus"

- Discipline of Belief
 - God is already at work
 - What God said about them is true Ps 139:14
 - Every person is of great value to God. Romans 5:8, John 3:16
 - God has a purpose great and wonderful plans for you.
 - God will finish the work He began

Slide 10 Relationship builder

- #1 factor on leading others to Christ.
- #1 factor creating an environment for change.
- Relationship comes first then change.
- Active Listener Slow to speak looks for meaning.
 - "We can only be loved to the extent we are known"
 - Requires being real present.
 - Asks big powerful questions.
 - Reflects paraphrases checks understanding
- Keeps them responsible setting goals decisions.
- Understands disciples are handcrafted not one size fits all.

Slide 11 How does this change most affectively occur?

In a relationship defined by these characteristics

- Safe there is a sin problem in the church hidden hurt
- Real (present, immediacy)
- Caring loving
- Empathetic
- Listening
- Not manipulative, judgmental
- Positive

Slide 12 Change is more likely to occur when:

- When hope is present.
- When men feel heard.
- When someone believes in them.
- When there is encouragement and support from the body of Christ.
- When they make the choice and stay in control.

Motivation is strongest when choice, goals, and personal investment stays with the one being mentored/discipled.

I am here by God's design. I surrender my will and join with Him and His purposes to help move this soul whom Jesus died, from where he is now towards Christ and His purposes for his life.

Fruitful journey Painful hurting decisions

All are significant – we can not measure the impact on this side of heaven nor should we spend time worrying.

Painful tears spent in prayer -YES, worry - NO

Slide 14 Find a few difficult people to help you grow!

- Recognize the impact of people on your life and you on theirs.
- Only God can touch the deepest part of the soul.
- There is no greater joy than seeing an eternal soul, a brother or sister in Christ, a child, a friend, an enemy, take a step closer to Jesus.
