DO'S AND DON'TS WITH GOD AND PEOPLE James 4:1-17 NLT

DON'T PREY ON OTHERS

James 4:1-4 (1) What is causing the quarrels and fights among you? Don't they come from the evil desires at war within you? (2) You want what you don't have, so you scheme and kill to get it. You are jealous of what others have, but you can't get it, so you fight and wage war to take it away from them. Yet you don't have what you want because you don't ask God for it. (3) And even when you ask, you don't get it because your motives are all wrong—you want only what will give you pleasure. (4) You adulterers! Don't you realize that friendship with the world makes you an enemy of God? I say it again: If you want to be a friend of the world, you make yourself and enemy of God.

2 Samuel 11:2-4 NLT (2) Late one afternoon, after his midday rest, David got out of bed and was walking on the roof of the palace. As he looked out over the city, he noticed a woman of unusual beauty taking a bath. (3) He sent someone to find out who she was, and he was told, "She is Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam and the wife of Uriah the Hittite." (4) Then David sent messengers to get her; and when she came to the palace, he slept with her.

DO PRAY TO GOD

James 4:5-10 (5) Do you think the Scriptures have no meaning? They say that God is passionate that the spirit he has placed within us should be faithful to him. (6) And he gives grace generously. As the Scriptures say, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." (7) So humble yourselves before God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. (8) Come close to God, and God will come close to you. Wash your hands, you sinners; purify your hearts, for your loyalty is divided between God and the world. (9) Let there be tears for what you have done. Let there be sorrow and deep grief. Let there be sadness instead of laughter, and gloom instead of joy. (10) Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up in honor.

DON'T POUND EACH OTHER

James 4:11-12 (11) Don't speak evil against each other, dear brothers and sisters. If you criticize and judge each other, then you are criticizing and judging God's law. But your job is to obey the law, not to judge whether it applies to you. (12) God alone, who gave the law, is the Judge. He alone has the power to save or destroy. So what right do you have to judge your neighbor?

John 13:34-35 NLT (34) "So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other. (35) Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples."

DO PLAN WITH GOD

James 4:13-17 (13) Look here, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we are going to a certain town and will stay there a year. We will do business there and make a profit." (14) How do you know what your life will be like tomorrow? Your life is like the morning fog—it's here a little while, then it's gone. (15) What you ought to say is, "If the Lord wants us to, we will live and do this or that." (16) Otherwise you are boasting about your own pretentious plans, and all such boasting is evil. (17) Remember, it is sin to know what you ought to do and then not do it.

Romans 7:18-25 NLT (18) And I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature. I want to do what is right, but I can't. (19) I want to do what is good, but I don't. I don't want to do what is wrong, but I do it anyway. (20) But if I do what I don't want to do, I am not really the one doing wrong; it is sin living in me that does it. (21) I have discovered this principle of life—that when I want to do what is right, I inevitably do what is wrong. (22) I love God's law with all my heart. (23) But there is another power within me that is at war with my mind. This power makes me a slave to the sin that is still within me. (24) Oh, what a miserable person I am! Who will free me from this life that is dominated by sin and death? (25) Thank God! The answer is in Jesus Christ our Lord. So you see how it is: In my mind I really want to obey God's law, but because of my sinful nature I am a slave to sin.

Romans 1:17 NLT This Good News tells us how God makes us right in his sight. This is accomplished from start to finish by faith. As the Scriptures say, "It is through faith that a righteous person has life."

2 THINGS THAT JUST MIGHT HELP...

1. Don' sit out the battles that God has for you.

2. Forgiveness doesn't wipe away all consequences.
