

Rethinking Power – Faith

1 Kings 18:20-40

Faith is believing God to do the impossible that his power would result in his glory!

1. **Faith is willing to stand alone**
2. **Faith is ready to pick a fight**
 - a. I Timothy 1:18 “This charge I commit to you, son Timothy, according to the prophecies previously made concerning you, that by them you may wage the good warfare,”
 - b. I Timothy 6:12 “Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, to which you were also called and have confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.”
 - c. II Timothy 4:7 “I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.”
3. **Faith acts before God moves**
 - a. Hebrews 11:1 “Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.”
 - b. “You do not test the resources of God till you try the impossible. F.B. Meyer
4. **Faith listens to God’s Word**
5. **Faith manifests the power of God**
 - a. Mark 6:5-6 “Now He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them. And He marveled because of their unbelief.”
