I believe the truth...

- I have everything I need for life and godliness (2 Peter 1:2-4).
- Jesus will never quit loving me. God's love for me is not based on my accomplishments. There is nothing I can do to make God love me more than He already perfectly does. And there is nothing I can do to make Him love me less (Romans 8:35-39).
- God will never leave me, abandon me or reject me. (Hebrews 13:5b-6).
- He will always forgive me and restore me when I repent (1 John 1:9).
- For the disciple of Jesus, it's not the wrath of God that disciplines us it's His love. He disciplines me because I am His beloved daughter. When God disciplines me, it's for my profit. (Hebrews 12:5-10).
- His mercy endures forever (1 Chronicles 16:34).
- He will always provide for me (Philippians 4:19, Matthew 7:11).
- He will give me wisdom if I ask for it and don't doubt (James 1:5-8).
- God is for me; not against me (Psalm 118:6, Romans 8:31).
- The Holy Spirit is at work in me to make me more like Jesus and through me to minister to other people; He does the work so I shouldn't claim that I can't. I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me (2 Corinthians 3:18; Romans 8:3,11; 2 Corinthians 3:5-6; Philippians 4:13).
- Jesus is making me a fisher of men as I follow Him (Mark 1:17).
- God is good. Because God is good, He will see me through whatever circumstance I am facing (Psalm 34:8; Psalm 147:5). God is my refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble (Psalm 46:1-3).
- My weakness is an asset in my walk with God. When I am weak, God is strong, and His strength is more than sufficient (2 Corinthians 12:9-10).
- I can come boldly to the throne of grace and find mercy and grace to help me in my time of need (Hebrews 4:14-16). God never gets tired of me coming to Him (Psalm 86:15).
- God will <u>not</u> relinquish His grip on me (John 10:28-29).
- God never calls me a loser; there is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus (Romans 8:1).
- Because I am in Jesus, the wrath of God against me has been fully satisfied (1 John 2:1-2; Romans 5:9-11; 1 Thessalonians 1:9-10).
- God can't lie and His word is true. So if my feelings don't line up with the Word of God, it's my feelings that need to change not the word or the character of God (Hebrews 6:17-18). His word brings change (Isaiah 55:10-11).
- Jesus and the Holy Spirit are interceding for me (Romans 8:26 and 34; Hebrews 7:25).
- God is sovereign and even if I don't like a decision, God is still at work. God will never mismanage my life. I am not omniscient; I can't see all that God is doing and that is OK. (Daniel 4:34-35; Psalm 103:19; John 5:17; Matthew 10:29-31, Romans 8:28).
- I have value to God; I matter to Him but so does <u>every</u> person. I need to value all people as God does and to not assign my own value to a person (John 3:16; Luke 12:24; Matthew 10:29-31).
- God heals my broken places and forgives all my sins (Isaiah 53:4-5; Psalm 147:3,5; Isaiah 57:15-16; Psalm 107:19-21).
- God is my protection (2 Chronicles 16:9a and Psalm 34:7-8).
- Goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life (Psalm 23:4-6).
- Since God is for me, it doesn't matter who is against me (Romans 8:31-35).

Jesus is always with me and if He is with me, I am OK.
