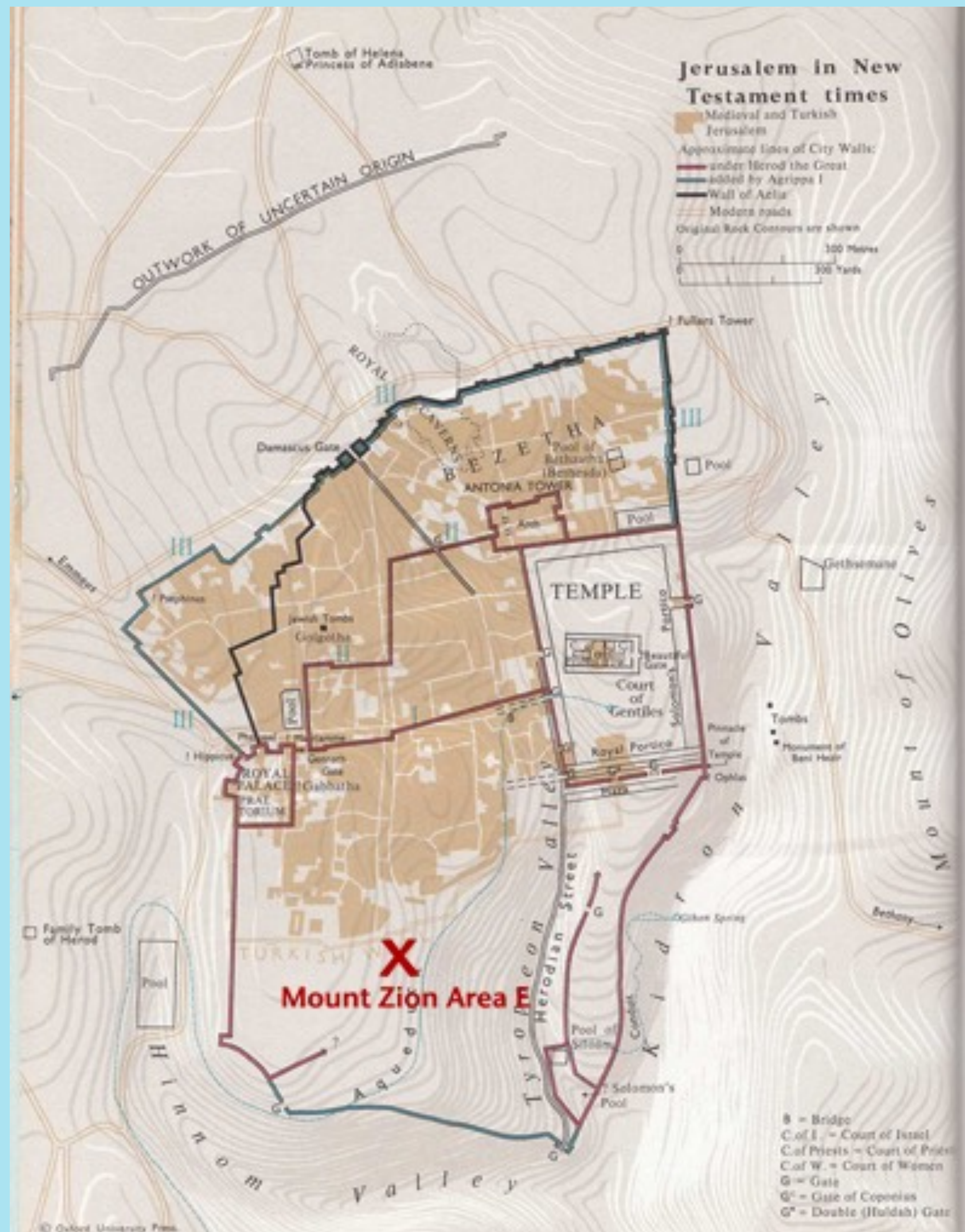

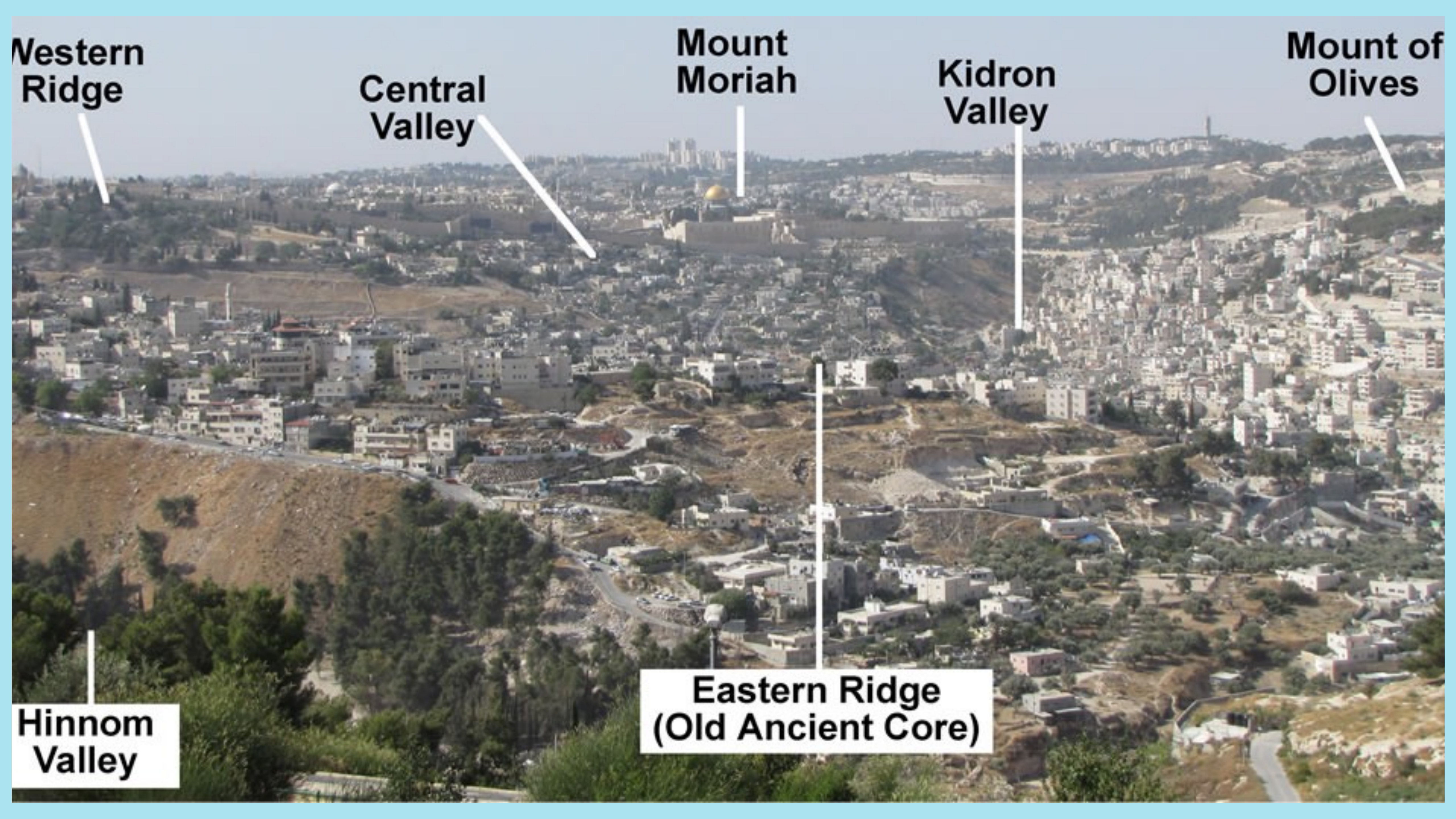

## **Outbursts in 1 Chronicles**

13:2 David said to all the assembly of Israel, ‘If it seems good to you ... **let us send out** to our brethren everywhere ... that they may gather together to us; and let us bring the ark of our God back to us.

13:11 And David became angry because of the Lord’s **outbreak** against Uzza; therefore that place is called **Perez** Uzza to this day.

14:11 Then David said, “God has **broken through** my enemies by my hand like a breakthrough of water.” Therefore they called the name of that place **Baal Perazim**.



## 1 Chronicles 15:11-16

And David called for Zadok and Abiathar the priests, and for the Levites: for Uriel, Asaiah, Joel, Shemaiah, Eliel, and Amminadab. He said to them, “You are the heads of the fathers’ houses of the Levites; sanctify yourselves, you and your brethren, that you may bring up the ark of the Lord God of Israel to the place I have prepared for it. For because you did not do it the first time, the Lord our God **broke out** against us, because we did not consult Him about the proper order.”

So the priests and the Levites sanctified themselves to bring up the ark of the Lord God of Israel. And the children of the Levites bore the ark of God on their shoulders, by its poles, as Moses had commanded according to the word of the Lord.

Then David spoke to the leaders of the Levites to appoint their brethren to be the singers accompanied by instruments of music, stringed instruments, harps, and cymbals, by raising the voice with resounding joy.

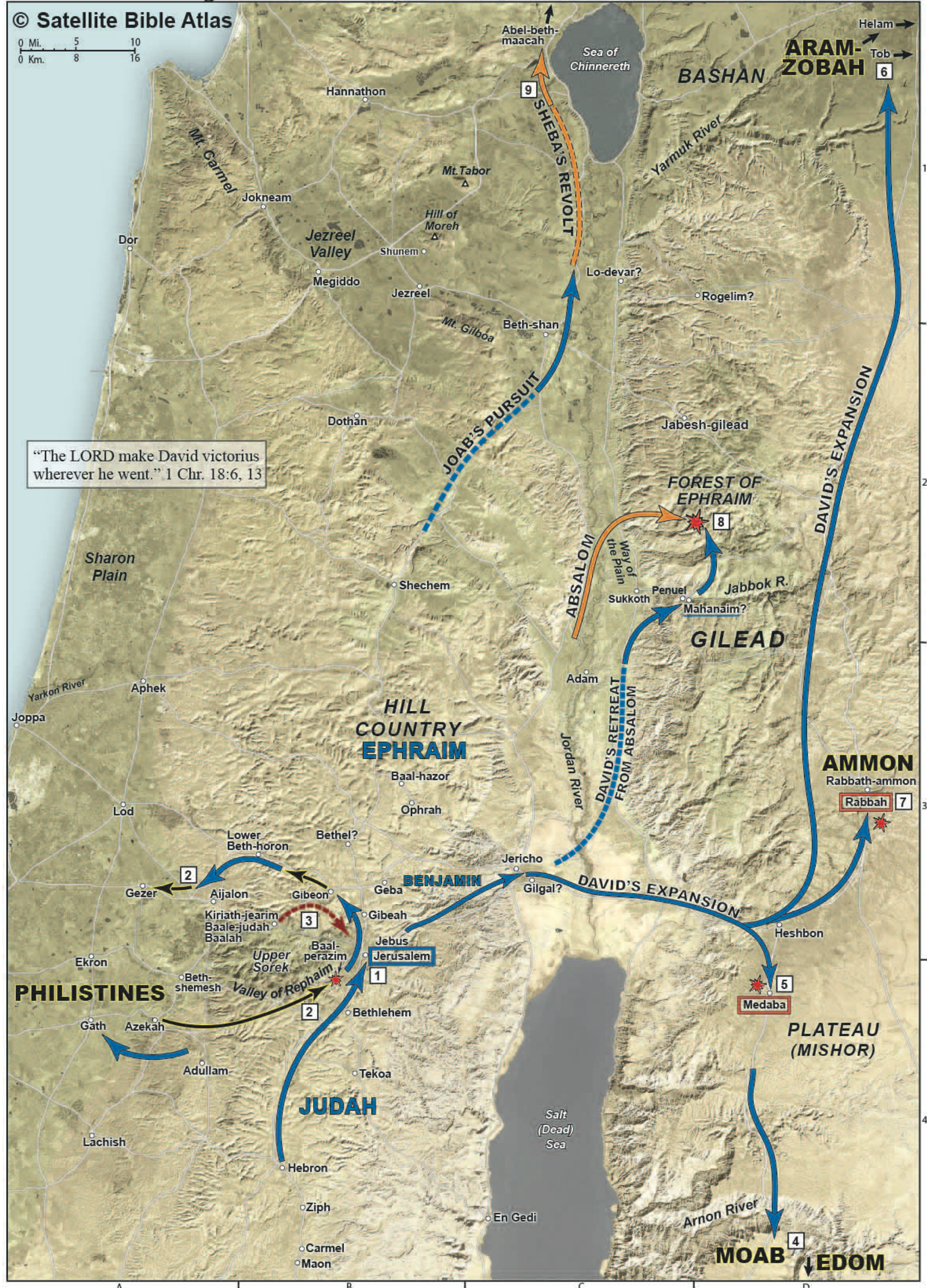
