

Acts 20:1-3

¹ When the uproar had ended, Paul sent for the disciples and, after ***encouraging*** them (*parakaleo*), said goodbye and set out for Macedonia. ² He traveled through that area, speaking many words of ***encouragement*** (*parakaleo*) to the people, and finally arrived in Greece, ³ where he stayed three months.



Acts 20:3-6

Because some Jews had plotted against him just as he was about to sail for Syria, he decided to go back through Macedonia.⁴ He was accompanied by Sopater son of Pyrrhus from ***Berea***, Aristarchus and Secundus from ***Thessalonica***, Gaius from ***Derbe***, Timothy also, and Tychicus and Trophimus from the province of ***Asia***.

Acts 20:3-6

⁵ These men went on ahead and waited for us at Troas. ⁶ But we sailed from Philippi after the Festival of Unleavened Bread, and five days later joined the others at Troas, where we stayed seven days.

Acts 20:7

⁷ On *the first day of the week* we came together *to break bread*. Paul *spoke to* (*preached, exhorted*) the people and, because he intended to leave the next day, kept on talking until midnight.



Acts 20:17-18

¹⁷ From Miletus, Paul sent to Ephesus for the elders of the church. ¹⁸ When they arrived, he said to them: “***You know how I lived the whole time I was with you, from the first day I came into the province of Asia.***”

Acts 20:19

19 I served the Lord with great humility and with tears and in the midst of severe testing by the plots of my Jewish opponents.

Acts 20:20-21


²⁰ You know that I have not hesitated to ***preach anything that would be helpful to you*** but have taught you ***publicly and from house to house.***

²¹ I have declared to ***both Jews and Greeks*** that they must turn to God in repentance and have faith in our Lord Jesus.

Acts 20:20-21

²² “And now, compelled by the Spirit, I am going to Jerusalem, not knowing what will happen to me there. ²³ I only know that in every city the Holy Spirit warns me that prison and hardships are facing me. ²⁴ However, I consider my life worth nothing to me; ***my only aim is to finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me***—the task of testifying to the good news of God’s grace.
