Enjoying God... or Not

Teleology

- "The doctrine of the design of the material world."
- Our Enjoyment of God glorifies God, brings us joy, and fuels our discipleship
- But there are different ideologies with different teleology(s).

A World in Rebellion

- Mimesis Regards the world as having a given order and a given meaning that humans must find and conform to.
- Poiesis Sees the world as raw material out which meaning and purpose can be created by the individual

It is rebellion, the creature's stepping outside of the creature's only possible attitude, the creature's becoming creator, the destruction of creatureliness, a defection, a falling away from being safely held as a creature."

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Wolfhart Pannenberg

• Sin is the "consciousness of the failure of the self" understood as the failure to align ourselves with our *telos (Anthropology in Theological Perspective)*.
