Responsive Readings are one of the most ancient worship practices of God's people. Israel used readings like Psalm 136 as a lively call-and-response. When we engage in responsive readings, we connect with saints who lived long, long ago and share the delightful and creative practice of reading God's word together corporately.

Today is Trinity Sunday. Today in the church calendar, we celebrate one of the most important doctrines of the Christian faith—we worship a Triune God. We believe that God exists as one God, yet three Persons, and we learn this paradox from the Scriptures. How should we react to something so hard to understand?

First, we should focus on the aspects of the Trinity that we *can* understand and apply. For one, God's tri-unity means that He exists *in community*...He experiences community with Himself, and we, being His image-bearers, are likewise built for community with Him and with others.
