

STUDY THE TEXT



Textual Commentary:

- The Jewish people began counting daily hours at 6am. The narrative begins at 12pm - noon.
- 2. The text is literal concerning darkness. This indicates a supernatural event.
- 3. The torn veil is significant.
- After receiving the fullness of God's wrath, Jesus still models complete faith in the Father.
- 5. The pagan witness is converted.
- Those who were witness understood the indignation of the cross.

Luke 23:44-49

44 It was now about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour, 45 while the sun's light failed. And the curtain of the temple was torn in two. 46 Then Jesus, calling out with a loud voice, said, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!" And having said this he breathed his last. 47 Now when the centurion saw what had taken place, he praised God, saying, "Certainly this man was innocent!" 48 And all the crowds that had assembled for this spectacle, when they saw what had taken place, returned home beating their breasts. 49 And all his acquaintances and the women who had followed him from Galilee stood at a distance watching these things.


THE VEIL IS TORN!

Luke 23:45: "And the curtain of the temple was torn in two."


Matthew 27:51: "And behold, the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. And the earth shook, and the rocks were split."

Mark 15:38: "And the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom."







HEBREWS 10:19-24: "19 Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, 20 by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, 21 and since we have a great priest over the house of God, 22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. 23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful. 24 And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, 25 not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near."




