- Godly parenting <u>DOES</u> matter.

T.R.A.I.N.-ing Wheels

1) TEACH them about Jesus.

You must love the Lord your God with your whole mind, your whole being, and all your strength. **6** These words I am commanding you today must be kept in mind, **7** and you must teach them to your children and speak of them as you sit in your house, as you walk along the road, as you lie down, and as you get up. – Deuteronomy 6:5-7

2) RESIST exasperating them.

Fathers, do not aggravate your children, or they will become discouraged. – Colossians 3:21

3) A<u>CCENTUATE</u> the positive.

Don't use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them. – Ephesians 4:29

4) INVEST relationally.

Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves. Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too. – Philippians 2:3-4

5) N<u>EVER</u> give up.

For I can do everything through Christ, who gives me strength. – Philippians 4:13
