MISCONCEPTIONS ABOUT FORGIVENESS

- We think it means FORGIVE AND FORGET.
- We think it means letting people OFF THE HOOK.
- We think it means **A FEELING**.

Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing." – Luke 23:34

• Forgiveness: the **CHOICE** to give up my right to get even.

KEEPING NO RECORD OF WRONGS

1) Cancel the <u>DEBT</u>.

Get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander, as well as all types of evil behavior. ³² Instead, be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you. – Ephesians 4:31-32

The Lord is near the brokenhearted; he delivers those who are discouraged. – Psalm 34:18

2) Lose the **LEDGER**.

Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others. – Colossians 3:13

Love prospers when a fault is forgiven, but dwelling on it separates close friends. – Proverbs 17:9

3) Transfer your **BALANCE TO JESUS**.

So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. ² And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death.

- Romans 8:1-2
