- was written in **50 YEARS** by **9 WRITERS**.
- points to Jesus and the key verb is **GIVE**.

can be read in 63 DAYS.

THE NEW TESTAMENT CHALLENGE: READ IT FOR YOURSELF.

Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples.

Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

60 DAYS IN THE NEW TESTAMENT

1) Make it the FOUNDATION of my life.

Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house on solid rock. – Matthew 7:24

2) Give it the FIRST PART of my day.

But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. – Matthew 6:33

Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed.

3) Use it as a **WEAPON** for life's challenges.

¹³ Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm... ¹⁷ and take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. – Ephesians 6:13,17
