5 PRINCIPLES TO BE A DIFFERENCE MAKER AT WORK

1) Have the right <u>PERSPECTIVE</u>.

• Work is NECESSARY.

• Work isn't **EVERYTHING**.

INTEGRITY matters.

2) Work HARD.

Lazy people want much but get little, but those who work hard will prosper. – Proverbs 13:4
