SEVEN HEBREW WORDS FOR PRAISE

1) HALAL – to rave, boast, celebrate.

Then I will thank you in front of the great assembly. I will praise you before all the people. – Psalm 35:18

2) YADAH – to acknowledge in public; to give thanks.

I give you thanks, O Lord, with all my heart; I will sing your praises before the gods. – Psalm 138:1

3) BARAK – to bless by kneeling or bowing.

Let all that I am praise the lord; with my whole heart, I will praise his holy name. – Psalm 103:1

4) ZAMAR – making music to God with instruments.

It is good to give thanks to the Lord, to sing praises to the Most High. – Psalm 92:1

5) SHABACH– to address in a loud tone.

Your unfailing love is better than life itself; how I praise you!
– Psalm 63:3

6) TOWDAH - to lift hands in adoration.

I will offer you a sacrifice of thanksgiving and call on the name of the lord. – Psalm 116:17

7) TEHILLAH – exuberant singing.

I will extol the Lord at all times; his praise will always be on my lips. – Psalm 34:1
