Letting Go of Bitterness

³¹ Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. - Ephesians 4:31

1) Understand that bitterness is \underline{NOT} the fruit God wants to produce in me.

²² But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!

Galatians 5:22-23

2) Recognize how bitterness **IMPACTS** all areas of my life.

26 "In your anger do not sin": Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, ²⁷ and do not give the devil a foothold.
Ephesians 4:26-27

3) Choose to kill bitterness with <u>COMPASSION</u> and FORGIVENESS.

Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. - Ephesians 4:32
