### OVERCOMING GOSSIP

### 1) Are my conversations **HELPFUL** or **HURTFUL**?

Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. - Ephesians 4:29

A wicked scoundrel digs up evil, and his slander is like a scorching fire. <sup>28</sup> A perverse person spreads dissension, and a gossip separates the closest friends. - Proverbs 16:27-28

# 2) Am I making PRIVATE matters PUBLIC?

A gossip betrays a confidence, but a trustworthy person keeps a secret. - Proverbs 11:13

When arguing with your neighbor, don't betray another person's secret. <sup>10</sup> Others may accuse you of gossip, and you will never regain your good reputation. - Proverbs 25:9-10

## 3) Am I <u>PERMITTING</u> others to gossip?

Wrongdoers eagerly listen to gossip; liars pay close attention to slander - Proverbs 17:4

Where there is no wood a fire goes out, and where there is no gossip, contention ceases. - Proverbs 26:20
