1) Build your **CONFIDENCE**.

I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

2) Expand your **CONNECTIONS**.

The purposes of a person's heart are deep waters, but one who has insight draws them out. - Proverbs 20:5

When he came to Jerusalem, he tried to join the disciples, but they were all afraid of him, not believing that he really was a disciple.

Only one person accepted Saul as a genuine disciple, Barnabas, who became Saul's advocate to the apostles. - Acts 9:26-27

3) Improve your **COMPETENCE**.

The wise will listen and increase their learning, and the person of understanding will acquire wise counsel and the skill to steer his course wisely and lead others to the truth. - Proverbs 1:5
