The World's Way:

LOVE CHOICES

1) I will choose PATIENCE

Love is **patient...** - 1 Corinthians 13:4

2) I will choose **KINDNESS**.

⁴ Love is patient, love is **kind...** - 1 Corinthians 13:4

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. - Romans 5:8

3) I will choose HUMILITY.

- ⁴ Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is **not proud**. 1 Corinthians 13:4
- ⁵ In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: ⁶ Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; ⁷ rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. ⁸ And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death— even death on a cross! Philippians 2:5-8

4) I will choose **HONOR**.

It does not **dishonor others**, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. - 1 Corinthians 13:5
