4 CORE VALUES OF AN ALL-IN FOLLOWER OF JESUS

1) FREED TO FOLLOW.

For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. ²⁴ Yet God, in his grace, freely makes us right in his sight. He did this through Christ Jesus when he freed us from the penalty for our sins. – Romans 3:23-24

2) PURSUE WITH PURPOSE.

¹² I don't mean to say that I have already achieved these things or that I have already reached perfection. But I press on to possess that perfection for which Christ Jesus first possessed me. ¹³ No, dear brothers and sisters, I have not achieved it, but I focus on this one thing: Forgetting the past and looking forward to what lies ahead, ¹⁴ I press on to reach the end of the race and receive the heavenly prize for which God, through Christ Jesus, is calling us. - Philippians 3:12-14

3) BETTER TOGETHER.

All of you together are Christ's body, and each of you is a part of it. – 1 Corinthians 12:27

(Jesus) ²⁰ "I am praying not only for these disciples but also for all who will ever believe in me through their message... ²³ May they experience such perfect unity that the world will know that you sent me and that you love them as much as you love me." – John 17:20, 23

4) <u>SERVE THE WORLD</u>.

³⁷ Jesus replied, "'You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' ³⁸ This is the first and greatest commandment. ³⁹ A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'" - Matthew 22:37-39
