AS AN OVERCOMER THROUGH FAITH IN JESUS:

1) I can find <u>STRENGTH TO FIGHT</u> any enemy.

For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. 4 The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. - 2 Corinthians 10:3-4

In your strength I can crush an army; with my God I can scale any wall. - Psalm 18:29

2) I can <u>PERSEVERE</u> through any trial.

We now have this light shining in our hearts, but we ourselves are like fragile clay jars containing this great treasure. This makes it clear that our great power is from God, not from ourselves. ⁸ We are pressed on every side by troubles, but we are not crushed. We are perplexed, but not driven to despair. ⁹ We are hunted down, but never abandoned by God. We get knocked down, but we are not destroyed. - 2 Corinthians 4:7-9

3) I can <u>RESIST</u> any temptation.

A final word: Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. ¹¹ Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil. - Ephesians 6:10-11

4) I can know my faith will be <u>REWARDED</u>.

To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne. - Revelation 3:21
