INDEPENDENCE IN OUR CULTURE

- "I can handle it ON MY OWN."
- "I am my own <u>AUTHORITY</u>."
- "I do not NEED GOD."

Jesus calls His followers to live **IN DEPENDENCE** on God.

LIVING IN DEPENDENCE

1) Put God FIRST.

Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.
- Matthew 6:10

But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. - Matthew 6:33

2) Trust in God's PROVISION.

Give us today our daily bread. - Matthew 6:11

3) Depend on God's GRACE.
