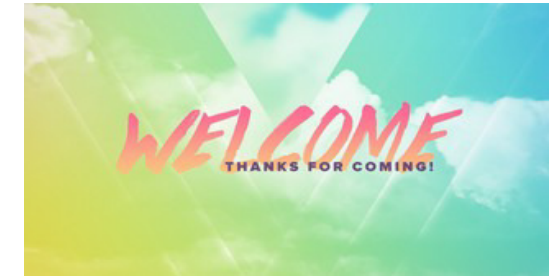

Introduction

Read Acts 1:1-11.

Discussion

1. Take a moment to share one joy & one challenge from your week.
2. What was the Main Idea of Sunday's message? What does it mean?

Examination

3. What do the disciples expect Jesus to do post-resurrection? How does Jesus respond to this question? What is the disconnect between the disciples expectation and Jesus reality?
4. Connect Acts 1:8 with Matthew 28:18-20. What similarities and differences are there? How might Acts 1:8 help us apply the Commission of Matthew 28:18-20?
5. What is essential, according to Jesus to the church's fulfillment of its mission?
6. How can Jesus' words in vs. 7 help keep us focused on the mission at hand?

Application

7. Have you experienced a time when your expectations of God's plan and His reality were different similar to what the disciples experienced? What happened?
8. How will you use your time this week to be a witness for Jesus?
