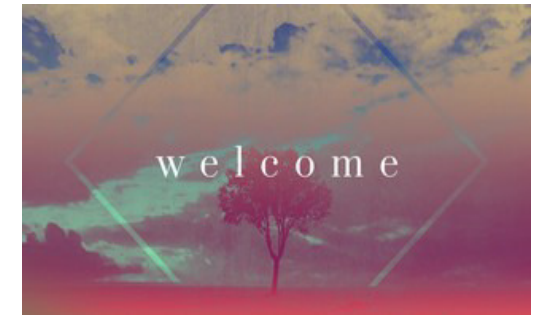

### Introduction

### Discussion

1. Take a moment to share one joy & one challenge from your week. 2. What was the Main Idea of Sunday's message? What does it mean?

### Examination

3. What do the disciples commit to as they return from Mount Olivet? How might this commitment influence our own church's mission?

4. Peter tells the gathered disciples that Judas was numbered among them and had a share in Jesus' ministry yet guided the arresting party. How might Judas serve as a warning to disciples of Jesus?

5. What are the essential requirements Peter lays out for Judas replacement? Why do you think Peter uses these particular requirements? What does Peter say will be the responsibility of this individual?

6. What truth about God can be found in vs. 24? Why is this significant in light of Judas' life and ministry?

### Application

7. Contrast Peter's denial of Jesus with Judas' betrayal. How are the two similar? How are they different? What lessons can you personally take from them?

8. How will you use your time this week to be a witness for Jesus?
