Read: Acts 17:1-15.

Discussion

1. What is your go to passage to share the gospel with someone? Why do you use this particular passage? What OT passages do you imagine Paul and Silas using to explain and prove that it was necessary for "the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead" (vs.3)?

Examination

2. Paul and Silas are accused of "turning the world upside down" (vs. 6). How does the Gospel actually turn the world right side up?
3. What does it mean to live "as if there is another king, Jesus" ?
4. Take some time to read 1 Thessalonians. Discuss the things we can learn about the disciples in Thessalonica from Paul's letter. In particular pay attention to 1 Thessalonians 1:1-10, 2:13-14 3:6, 4:9-10, 5:1-2,4,11.
5. Review Acts 17:10-15. How did the Bereans study the scriptures? What example do these believers set for the modern church?

6. In what ways might you establish new connections with your community (think neighborhood and city)?
7. How does your relationship to the scriptures compare to the Bereans? What practical action step can you commit to in order to grow your knowledge of the bible?



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
