Introduction

Read: Matthew 6:9-13, Luke 11:1-4

Discussion

1. Consider all the Shapes, Quadrant, Triangle, Circle, Square and Hexagon. Can you remember the scriptures each are connected to? Compare notes and compile an accurate list.
(Hint: Check the church APP if you get stuck)

Examination

2. Compare the two passages listed above. What is similar in the two prayers? What is different? What might the fact that the prayers are not identical teach us about prayer?
3. Diverse expressions exist in the Church with the Lord's Prayer. What has been your exposure and experience with the prayer? Has it been neutral, positive, or negative?
4. Examine the Hexagon shape. Can you reproduce the shape? Take turns sharing the shape with one another.

Application

5. What do you find most helpful about the Hexagon Shape as a pattern of prayer rather than a script for prayer?
6. Consider the six elements of Jesus' prayer: Character, Kingdom, Provision, Forgiveness, Guidance, Deliverance. Which element gets your attention? Which element are you in most need of currently?
7. Spend time as a group or on your own praying through the six elements. Create a plan to include them in your future prayer time.
