- 5. Discuss the practical benefits of Scripture in our lives. How does it guide us in understanding God's truth?
- 6. Share examples of how Scripture has corrected and shaped your thinking or behavior.
- 7. How does our understanding of Christ as the central figure impact our view of Scripture as the ultimate authority?
