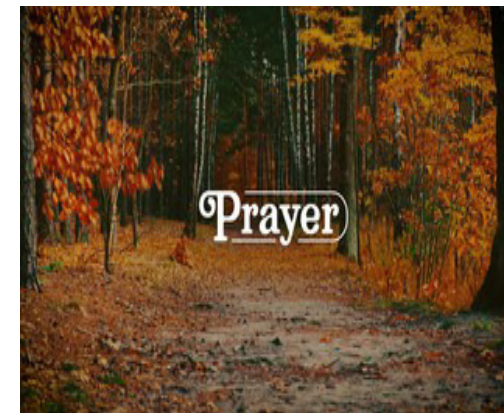

**Introduction**

Greet one another and Pray together before you begin discussion.  
Read Acts 10:34-48

**Discussion**

1. Take a moment to research the significance of Reformation Day. What can we learn from this moment in history?
2. What was the Main Idea of Sunday's message? What does it mean?

**Examination**

3. Create a brief outline of Peter's sermon. What is Peter's Main Idea?
4. Flash back to Peter's sermon in Acts 2:14-36. What are some similarities and differences between the two messages? Note the different cultural make up of listeners. What might the differences in Peter's approach have to teach us about sharing the gospel?
5. Ask this question from last week of this passage: What role does the Holy Spirit play in this episode? How might our evangelistic efforts to share the gospel with others become more Spirit led?

**Application**

6. How does Cornelius' conversion address the sin of partiality? Are the people you are prone to consider outsiders and enemies? What can Cornelius' conversion teach you?
7. What, based upon Peter's sermons as an example, must be the core of the Christian gospel?
8. Pray for opportunities to be a witness for Jesus this week.
