

October 30th, 2022 Acts: Conflict with Culture Acts 18:1-17



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Greet one another and pray before you begin discussion. Read: Acts 18:1-17

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1. How would you describe your city politically, commercially, morally and spiritually? What would change if the rulers and authorities were devoted to the gospel?

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- 2. Discuss Paul's journey up to this point. What kind of trials and difficulties had he experienced? (See Acts 15:36-41, 16:19-24, 17:5,13,32) How might these events help us understand Paul's statement in 1 Corinthians 2:1-3 and his statement in Acts 18:6?
- 3. What evidence is in chapter 18 of the Gospel taking root in Corinth? What would this same evidence look like in our church / city?
- 4. How do Priscilla and Aquila's ministry model the "ordinary" Christian life? How does their example broaden what it means to be a missionary?
- 5. What allowed Paul to devote himself to full time preaching (vs.5)? What does this teach about the church's role in advancing the gospel of Jesus Christ?

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- 6. What should Christians do when they are experiencing weakness and fear?
- 7. Paul spends a time tent-making in Corinth. How might you leverage your job for the gospel?

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
