MAIN IDEA: The people around Jesus represent two equal and opposite ways to be alienated from God.



Tax Collectors: earned a profit by demanding a higher tax from the people than they had prepaid to the Roman government.



Sinners: General term for those whose behavior and background has missed God's mark for life, rebelling against His word, will and ways.



We are told three things about the tax collectors and sinners:

1. They are Drawing near to Jesus

2. They are Eating a meal with Jesus

3. They are being received by Jesus



"The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and they say, 'Look at him! A glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and sinners!'

Matthew 11:19a, ESV



Who are the social and religious outcasts of our day?

Are they among us?

Or alienated by us?



Pharisees: A Jewish religious party who Followed a very strict adherence to the ritual law and to the oral traditions of the law.



Scribes: a class of scholars who teach, copy, and interpret the Jewish Law for the people. They appear in the Gospels primarily as opponents of Jesus.



"Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you tithe mint and dill and cumin, and have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faithfulness. These you ought to have done, without neglecting the others."

Matthew 23:23, ESV



"He also told this parable to some who trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and treated others with contempt: "Two men went up into the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector.

Luke 18:9-12, ESV



The Pharisee, standing by himself, prayed thus: 'God, I thank you that I am not like other men, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week; I give tithes of all that I get.'
