
How might studying spiritual gifts help us understand and pursue the calling God has placed on our lives?





How do our spiritual gifts connect to our mission to build the church and share the gospel?


Truth 2 - The Gifts are Spiritual


Definition:

Spiritual gifts are supernatural abilities given to believers to serve the church and build the Kingdom of God through the spread of the Gospel.




Question for Reflection:


