

- 5. Where can we make connections to Christ in Philemon?
- 6. Paul uses compelling language rather than commanding language when addressing Philemon. What leadership lessons might we learn from this?

- 7. Onesimus has quite the experience in this letter. Where have you similarly seen God use circumstances in your life that were negative to result in a gospel good?
