- 4. The church sits in the original location of the log cabin. (False. The location of the first several church buildings was across from the Little Prairie cemetery. In 1972 the 1909 structure burned down. Our present building was constructed here and dedicated in July 1973.)
- 5. LPCC has sent many young people into ministry and supported many missionaries of the gospel. (True)
- 6. LPCC continues to exist because God is leading and working through His people who faithfully serve Him according to their gifts. (True)
